The word "hope" in the Bible is not just wishful thinking but a confident, sure expectation and certainty of God's power to work in our lives.


Biblical "peace" is not the absence of war but knowing that no matter what happens to us God is in control.

May you have both HOPE and PEACE in the New Year



Here are some excerpts from a follow-up email after a meeting with Mark Gillman regarding a dire need for Christians to engage in the crisis being addressed by the organizations listed above. Please prayerfully consider your response as you join with Mark in his inspiring prayer toward the end of the statement.

...need for volunteers to help engage the community. This could include introductions or participating in the outreach ministries. We are compiling with all four groups a list of opportunities that is easy to understand and lets people know what getting involved means. Besides the interpersonal part of these ministries we are working to develop a unified strategy for public positioning and funding. We do have some people that know this space very well who will guide us on strategy here. We will let you know when we know more.

God, we know you have your countenance on these issues and that it grieves your heart to have so many of your children lost and afflicted. May you raise up 1000's of spokesmen among you that know you can do anything and make you bring forth many selfless foot soldiers.

Lord for each of us, may we choose to forgive those that have hurt us, offended us, abused us, despitefully used us or wronged us. Help us Lord to recognize the enemy's strategy to trap us in resentment, bitterness and unforgiveness that may keep us inwardly focused and keep us from using our gifts to fight this or other battles where our gifts are needed. Help us to be sensitive to your desire and keep us focused on how best we can serve.
