### A MESSAGE FROM THE ELDERS:

#### **Cladosporium-sphaerospermum**

Upon first reading, one might find similarity between Cladosporium-sphaerospermum and supercalifragilisticexpialidocious. After all, both are incredibly complex spellings of words that are both difficult to read and difficult to say aloud. If one did not know better, one might assume both are just made-up nonsensical gibberish. However, one will likely recognize the latter as the title and theme of a beloved children's song. The former, well, is a bit more complex, but suffice it to say, Cladosporium-sphaerospermum is actually evidence of our wildly imaginative and serendipitous Creator. Yes, really!

The Salvation Army is closing its day room January 1, 2026 and will cut meals to just 1 a day (sack lunches will be provided M-F). There is no funding. There is so much concern regarding how we are going to feed everyone. Many area churches provide meals Mon-Thurs. Many are unable to get there.



This leaves Friday Saturday and Sunday where we need the most prayer to see where we can fit in. We already have Sunday, thank you Jesus! The 2nd and 4th Saturdays are also covered. I really just wanted to keep everyone informed with changes in this community creating a massive void, which is absolutely ripe for the church (as in all of the churches who love Jesus and believe in the power of our God to still perform miracles working together) to get involved!

I was looking up the definition of miracle today, and believe fully in the miracles at work in our community!! I have seen the power of our God literally breaking chains...I have seen God multiply and provide in ways that are unexplainable!

Thank you Lord for this opportunity to really showcase your love through basic human needs. May our hospitality on the streets glorify your name!
