Heavenly Father...

- Day 1: Please do immeasurably more in <u>(Child's Name)</u> life than all we could ever ask or imagine, according to Your power that is at work within <u>him/her</u>. Glorify Yourself through <u>his/her</u> life, and for generations to come. (Ephesians 3:20-21)
- **Day 2:** Please turn (Child's Name) ear toward wisdom and <u>his/her</u> heart toward understanding. Give <u>him/her</u> a teachable spirit, one that calls out for insight and searches for it as for hidden treasure. (Prov. 2:2-4)

- **Day 31**: Please do not let any unwholesome talk come out of <u>(Child's Name)</u> mouth, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen. (Ephesians 4:29)
- Day 32: Please cause (Child's Name) to obey <u>his/her</u> teachers and coaches and submit to their authority. - **Day 38:** Please show (Child's Name) that all Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting, and training in righteousness. (2 Timothy 3:16)
- Day 39: Above all, let (Child's Name) love others deeply, because love covers over a multitude of sins. - Day 75: Please cause (Child's Name) to follow You, and make him/her a fisher of people. (Matthew 4:19)

- Day 78: May (Child's Name) sin find <u>him/her</u> out, so that <u>he/she</u> will be drawn back to You, Lord, for forgiveness and Your gracious blessing of a new beginning. (Numbers 32:23)
- **Day 79:** Please let (Child's Name) be wise in what is good and innocent in what is evil. (Romans 16:19)
- **Day 80**: Please show (<u>Child's Name</u>) how to use <u>his/her</u> gifts and talents wisely; being faithful with the abilities You have given <u>him/her</u>. (Matthew 25:21)
- **Day 81:** Please let <u>(Child's Name)</u> seek friendship with You rather than with the world, remembering that anyone who chooses to be a friend of the world becomes Your enemy. (James 4:4)

- **Day 83:** Lord, teach (Child's Name) perseverance in all <u>he/she</u> does, and help <u>him/her</u> especially to run with perseverance the race marked out for <u>him/her</u>. (Heb. 12:1)
- **Day 84:** Please help (Child's Name) to submit to You, O God, and to resist the devil. Make the devil flee from (Child's Name) as he/she draws near to You. (James 4:7-8)
- **Day 85:** Please give (Child's Name) the mind of Christ. (1 Corinthians 2:16)
- **Day 86:** Please keep (Child's Name) as the apple of Your eye; hide <u>him/her</u> in the shadow of Your wings from the wicked who assail <u>him/her</u>, from the mortal enemies who surround <u>him/her</u>. (Psalm 17:8-9)
- **Day 87:** Please bless (Child's Name) with friends, and let <u>him/her</u> be a friend to the friendless, since "two are better than one...if one falls down, <u>his/her</u> friend can help <u>him/her</u> up. But pity the <u>man</u> who falls and has no one to help <u>him/her</u> up!" (Ecclesiastes 4:9-10)
- Day 88: I pray that (Child's Name) will do everything without arguing or complaining. (Philippians 2:14)
- **Day 89:** Please let <u>(Child's Name)</u> stand strong. Do not let anything change <u>him/her</u>. Help <u>him/her</u> to always give <u>himself</u> fully to Your work, because his/her work in the Lord is never wasted. (1 Corinthians 15:58)
- **Day 90:** Please fulfill Your purpose for <u>(Child's Name)</u>; do not abandon the work of Your hands. (Psalm 138:8)
- **Day 91:** Please give (Child's Name) a grateful heart, and equip <u>him/her</u> to rejoice, to pray and to give thanks in all circumstances. (1 Thessalonians 5:16-18)
- **Day 92:** You promise to tend Your flock like a shepherd. Gather <u>(Child's Name)</u> like a lamb in Your arms and carry <u>him/her</u> close to Your heart. And, just as You promise to gently lead those that have young, teach us, as parents, how to lead and guide and care for <u>(Child's Name)</u>. (Isaiah 40:11)
- **Day 93:** I pray that <u>(Child's Name)</u> will continue to live in Christ, rooted and built up in Him, strengthened in the faith as <u>he/she</u> was taught, and overflowing with thankfulness. (Colossians 2:6-7)
- **Day 94:** I pray that <u>(Child's Name)</u> would confess with <u>his/her</u> mouth that Jesus is Lord, and <u>he/she</u> would believe in <u>his/her</u> heart that You have raised Christ from the dead. - **Day 99:** Please cause <u>(Child's Name)</u> to make every effort to add to <u>his/her</u> faith, goodness; and to goodness, knowledge; and to knowledge, self-control; and to self-control, perseverance; and to perseverance, godliness; and to godliness, kindness, and to kindness, love. Let <u>(Child's Name)</u> possess these qualities in increasing measure, so that <u>he/she</u> will be effective and productive in <u>his/her</u> knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. (2 Peter 1:5-8)
- **Day 100:** Please let <u>(Child's Name)</u> open <u>his/her</u> arms to the poor and extend <u>his/her</u> hands to the needy. (Proverbs 31:20)

- **Day 101:** Please let <u>(Child's Name)</u> take refuge in You and be glad; let <u>him/her</u> ever sing for joy. Spread Your protection over <u>(Child's Name)</u> that <u>he/she</u> may rejoice in You. (Psalm 5:11)
- **Day 102:** Please let <u>(Child's Name)</u> grow as Jesus did, in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and men. (Luke 2:52)
- **Day 103:** Please hem <u>(Child's Name)</u> in behind and before; place Your hand upon <u>him/her</u> so that wherever <u>he/she</u> goes and whatever <u>he/she</u> does, <u>he/she</u> will be accompanied by your presence. (Psalm 139:5-10)
- Day 104: Please shape (Child's Name) into a friend who loves at all times. (Proverbs 17:17)
- **Day 105:** Please let <u>(Child's Name)</u> and <u>his/her</u> siblings be encouraged and knit together with strong ties of love. Let them have the rich experience of knowing Christ with real certainty and clear understanding. (Colossians 2:2)
- **Day 106:** Please help (<u>Child's Name</u>) to see that although <u>he/she</u> may have small troubles for awhile now; they are helping <u>him/her</u> gain an eternal glory that is much greater than the troubles. Set <u>his/her</u> eyes not on what <u>he/she</u> can see but on what <u>he/she</u> cannot see because what <u>he/she</u> sees will last only a short time, but what <u>he/she</u> cannot see will last forever. (2 Corinthians 5:17-18)

- **Day 107:** Please let (<u>Child's Name</u>) keep our commands and never forsake our teaching. Let <u>him/her</u> bind them upon <u>his/her</u> heart forever and fasten them around <u>his/her</u> neck. When <u>he/she</u> walks, let our teaching guide <u>him/her</u>; when <u>he/she</u> sleeps, let it watch over <u>him/her</u>; when <u>he/she</u> wakes, let our words speak to <u>him/her</u>. Let (<u>Child's Name</u>) regard our instruction and our commands as a guiding lamp; let <u>him/her</u> welcome our correction as the way to life. (Proverbs 6:20-23)
- **Day 108:** Thank You that no eye has seen, no ear has heard, no mind can conceive what You have prepared for <u>(Child's Name)</u> because <u>he/she</u> loves You. Cause <u>him/her</u> to be willing to wait on You, and act on <u>his/her</u> behalf. (1 Corinthians 2:9 / Isaiah 64:4)

Direct (Child's Name) in the path of Your commands, and let <u>him/her</u> find delight there. Turn <u>his/her</u> heart toward Your statutes and not toward selfish gain. (Psalm 119:33-36)
- **Day 111:** Thank You for loving (<u>Child's Name</u>) so much that You gave Your one and only Son, that when (<u>Child's Name</u>) believes in Him <u>he/she</u> will not perish but have eternal life. (John 3:16)
- **Day 112:** Please do not let <u>(Child's Name)</u> merely listen to the Word, and so deceive <u>himself</u>. Let him/her do what it says. (James 1:22)
- **Day 113:** Please cause <u>(Child's Name)</u> to be diligent in developing <u>his/her</u> gifts and talents so that <u>he/she</u> will become "skilled in his/her work" and "serve before kings," using <u>his/her</u> abilities to fulfill Your purposes. (Proverbs 22:29)
- **Day 114:** Please let <u>(Child's Name)</u> become blameless and pure, a child of God without fault in a crooked and depraved generation, and let <u>(Child's Name)</u> shine like a star in the universe as <u>he/she</u> holds out the Word of life. (Philippians 2:15-16)
- **Day 115:** Please instill in <u>(Child's Name)</u> a soul that 'followeth hard after thee ,' one that clings passionately to you. (Psalm 63:8)
- **Day 116:** Please motivate <u>(Child's Name)</u> to serve wholeheartedly, as if <u>he/she</u> were serving You, not people, and remind his/her that You will reward everyone for whatever good they do. (Ephesians 6:7-8)
- **Day 117:** Thank You for showing compassion to us, I pray that <u>(Child's Name)</u> would follow Your example, being compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in love. (Psalm 103:8)
- **Day 118:** Please make <u>(Child's Name)</u> self controlled and alert. His enemy the devil prowls around like roaring lion looking for someone to devour. Help him/her to resist him/her and stand firm in his/her faith. (1 Peter 5:8-9)
- Day 119: Lord, You are faithful. Please strengthen and protect (Child's Name) from the evil one. (2 Thess. 3:3)

- **Day 123:** Thank You Lord that You have special plans for <u>(Child's Name)</u> and have set <u>him/her</u> apart for Your work even before <u>he/she</u> was born by calling <u>him/her</u> through Your grace. (Galatians 1:15)
- **Day 124:** Please don't let <u>(Child's Name)</u> exclude <u>his/her</u> peers or participate in gossip, since a gossip causes trouble and separates close friends. (Proverbs 16:28)
- **Day 125:** Please do not permit <u>(Child's Name)</u> to be quarrelsome; instead, cause <u>him/her</u> to be gentle, patient and humble. (2 Timothy 2:22-24)
- **Day 126:** Please let us learn self discipline as a gift. Let <u>(Child's Name)</u> recognize that when we discipline <u>him/her</u>, it means that we love <u>him/her</u> and that <u>he/she</u> belongs to our family just as You discipline those You love, those You accept as Your sons and daughters. Let <u>(Child's Name)</u> respect us when we discipline <u>him/her</u>, realizing that we are doing our best and that we ourselves are submitting to Your discipline, which is for our good. (Hebrews 12:5-10)
- **Day 127:** Please cause <u>(Child's Name)</u> to be wise in the way <u>he/she</u> acts, making the most of every opportunity. When <u>he/she</u> talks, help <u>him/her</u> to always be kind and pleasant so <u>he/she</u> will be able to answer everyone in the way <u>he/she</u> should. (Colossians 4:5-6)
- **Day 128:** Thank You for beginning a good work in <u>(Child's Name)</u>, and that You will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus. (Philippians 1:6)
- **Day 129:** I pray that <u>(Child's Name)</u> will have greater understanding in <u>his/her</u> heart so <u>he/she</u> will know the hope to which You have called us and that <u>he/she</u> will know how rich and glorious are the blessings God has promised His holy people. (Ephesians 1:18)
- **Day 130:** Please cause (Child's Name) to obey his/her parents. Let <u>him/her</u> honor his/her father and mother, so that all may go well with <u>him/her</u> and that <u>he/she</u> may enjoy a long life on earth. (Ephesians 6:1-3)
- **Day 131:** Please let Your Spirit rest on <u>(Child's Name)</u>. Give <u>him/her</u> the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and power, the Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the Lord – that <u>he/she</u> might delight in the fear of the Lord. - **Day 136:** Please fill (<u>Child's Name</u>) with Your Holy Spirit, that <u>he/she</u> might bear the Spirit's fruit: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. (Galatians 5:22-23)
- **Day 137:** Please prepare (Child's Name) mind for action. Let <u>him/her</u> be self-controlled, with <u>his/her</u> hope set fully on the grace to be given <u>him/her</u> when Jesus Christ is revealed. (1 Peter 1:13)

- **Day 142:** Please teach (Child's Name) to realize that each day is a gift from You; help <u>him/her</u> to spend them as <u>he/she</u> should. (Psalm 90:12)
- **Day 143:** Let (Child's Name) know that <u>he/she</u> belongs to You. (Romans 14:7-9)
- **Day 144:** Create in <u>(Child's Name)</u> a pure heart, O God, and let that purity of heart be shown in <u>his/her</u> actions. (Psalm 51:10)
- Day 145: Please make Your Word a lamp to <u>(Child's Name)</u>'s feet and a light for <u>his/her</u> path. (Ps. 119:105)
- Day 146: Please equip (Child's Name) with everything good for doing Your will. (Hebrews 13:21)

- **Day 147:** When <u>(Child's Name)</u> is confronted with grief, uncertainty, fear, or pressure, remind <u>him/her</u> of Your promise that <u>he/she</u> does not need to fear, for You are with <u>him/her</u>; <u>he/she</u> does not need to be dismayed, for You are <u>his/her</u> God and You will strengthen <u>him/her</u> and help <u>him/her</u>. You will uphold <u>him/her</u> with Your right hand. (Isaiah 41:10)
- **Day 148:** Please let (<u>Child's Name</u>) praise You with all <u>his/her</u> heart and soul and never forget Your benefits. Forgive <u>his/her</u> sins, heal <u>his/her</u> diseases, redeem <u>his/her</u> life, and crown <u>him/her</u> with love and compassion. Satisfy <u>his/her</u> desires with good things. Let (<u>Child's Name</u>) know that from everlasting to everlasting, Your love is with those who fear You, and Your righteousness will be with <u>his/her</u> children's children as they keep Your commandments and remember to obey Your precepts. (Psalm 103:1-5, 17-18)
- **Day 149:** Please let (Child's Name) be willing to forgive not seven times, but in unlimited amounts. Let <u>him/her</u> have pity on others, acting with patience and mercy in all things. (Matthew 18:21-35)
- Day 150: Help (Child's Name) run from sex sin. No other sin affects the body as this one does. (1 Cor. 6:18) For You want (Child's Name) to be holy and pure, and to keep clear of all sexual sin so that <u>he/she</u> will marry in holiness and honor not in lustful passion as the heathen do, in their ignorance of God and His ways. (1 Thess. 4:3-5)
- **Day 151:** Please do not give <u>(Child's Name)</u> a spirit of timidity, but a spirit of power, of love and of selfdiscipline. (2 Timothy 1:7)
- **Day 152:** Please do not let anyone lead <u>(Child's Name)</u> astray. Cause <u>him/her</u> to do what is righteous rather than what is sinful. Thank You for sending Your Son to destroy the devil's work. (1 John 3:7-8)
- Day 153: Please clothe (Child's Name) with Your full armor so that <u>he/she</u> can take <u>his/her</u> stand against the devil's schemes. Help <u>him/her</u> to stand firm, with the belt of truth and the breastplate of righteousness. Fit <u>his/her</u> feet with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace. Give (Child's <u>Name</u>) the shield of faith, with which <u>he/she</u> can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. Place the helmet of salvation on <u>his/her</u> head and the sword of the Spirit, which is Your word, in <u>his/her</u> hands. Finally, teach <u>him/her</u> to pray, and to be alert. (Ephesians 6:11-18)
- **Day 154:** Please let <u>(Child's Name)</u> do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but in humility consider others better than <u>him/her</u>. Let <u>him/her</u> look not only to <u>his/her</u> own interests, but also to the interests of others, and let <u>his/her</u> attitude be the same as that of Christ Jesus. (Philippians 2:3-5)
- **Day 155:** Please comfort (Child's Name) in all <u>his/her</u> troubles, so that <u>he/she</u> may comfort those in any trouble with the comfort <u>he/she</u> has received from You, precious Lord. (2 Corinthians 1:4)
- Day 156: Please cause (Child's Name) to fear You, since this is the beginning of wisdom. Cause (Child's Name) to know You, and to understand Your perspective on any situation. Add years to his/her life, and give him/her the reward of the wise. (Proverbs 9:10-12)
- **Day 157:** Please help <u>(Child's Name)</u> to be alert, standing firm in <u>his/her</u> faith, having courage, and doing everything in love. (1 Corinthians 16:13-14)
- **Day 158:** Please let <u>(Child's Name)</u> sing of Your great love forever; let <u>him/her</u> make known Your faithfulness through all generations. (Psalm 89:1)

- **Day 162:** As we pray for <u>(Child's Name)</u>, do not let <u>him/her</u> be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, let <u>(Child's Name)</u> always remember to present <u>his/her</u> requests to You. And let Your peace, which transcends all understanding, guard <u>his/her</u> heart and mind in Christ Jesus. (Philippians 4:6-7)
- **Day 163:** Please fill <u>(Child's Name)</u> with the knowledge of Your will through all spiritual wisdom and understanding, so that <u>he/she</u> may live a life worthy of You and may please You in every way; bearing fruit in every good work and growing in the knowledge of You, Lord. (Colossians 1:9-10)
- **Day 164:** Please don't let <u>(Child's Name)</u> be arrogant or put <u>his/her</u> hope in wealth, which is so uncertain, but let <u>him/her</u> put <u>his/her</u> hope in You. Let <u>him/her</u> enjoy all that You have provided for <u>him/her</u>, and cause <u>him/her</u> to be rich in good deeds, being generous and always willing to share. Let <u>(Child's Name)</u> lay up treasure for <u>himself</u> as a firm foundation for the coming age, so that <u>he/she</u> can take hold of the life that is truly life. (1 Timothy 6:17-19)
- Day 165: Please let (Child's Name) be diligent, O Lord, and satisfy all his/her desires. (Proverbs 13:4)

- Day 173 : Grant that (Child's Name) may learn responsibility, for each should carry his/her own load. (Gal. 6:5)
- **Day 174:** Please cultivate in (Child's Name) the ability to show true humility toward all. (Titus 3:2)
- Day 175: We have prayed for <u>(Child's Name)</u>, and You have granted us what we have asked. So now we give <u>him/her</u> to You, Lord. For <u>his/her</u> whole life <u>he/she</u> will be given over to the Lord. (1 Samuel 1:27-28)
- **Day 176:** Please let (Child's Name) live in harmony, being sympathetic, compassionate, and humble. Don't let (Child's Name) repay evil with evil or insult with insult, but with blessing. (1 Peter 3:8-9)

- **Day 180:** Please keep (<u>Child's Name</u>) from the snares the enemy has laid for <u>him/her</u>, from the traps of the evildoers. Let the wicked fall into their own nets, while <u>he/she</u> passes by in safety. (Psalm 141:9-10)
