## *Heavenly Father...*

**Day 1:** Please do immeasurably more in (Child's Name) life than all we could ever ask or imagine, according to Your power that is at work within him/her. Glorify Yourself through his/her life, and for generations to come. (Ephesians 3:20-21)

**Day 2:** Please turn (Child's Name) ear toward wisdom and his/her heart toward understanding. Give him/her a teachable spirit, one that calls out for insight and searches for it as for hidden treasure. (Prov. 2:2-4)

**Day 3:** Please let (Child's Name) keep Your Words and store up Your commands so that he/she will live. Cause him/her to guard Your teachings as the apple of his/her eye, and let them be written on the tablet of his/her heart. (Proverbs 7:2-3)

**Day 4:** Please don't let (Child's Name) become weary in doing good. Let him/her know that at the proper time he/she will reap a harvest if he/she does not give up. (Galatians 6:9)

**Day 5:** Please show (Child's Name) how to use his/her gifts and talents wisely; being faithful with the abilities You have given him/her. (Matthew 25:21)

**Day 6:** Please give (Child's Name) a sense of destiny, and show him/her that You set him/her apart and appointed him/her with gifts and talents even before he/she was born. (Jeremiah 1:5)

**Day 7:** Please give (Child's Name) victory and be his/her shield. Guard his/her course and protect his/her way. (Proverbs 2:7-8)

**Day 8:** Please clothe (Child's Name) with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience. (Colossians 3:12)

**Day 9:** Please cause (Child's Name) to love his/her enemies, to do good to those who hate him/her, to bless those that curse him/her, to pray for those who mistreat him/her. Help (Child's Name) to treat others the way he/she wants to be treated. (Luke 6:27-31)

**Day 10:** No temptation has seized (Child's Name) except what is common to man. And You are faithful; You will not let him/her be tempted beyond what he/she can bear. But when (Child's Name) is tempted, You will also provide a way out so that he/she can stand up under it. Help him/her to take that way out. (1 Cor. 10:13)

**Day 11:** Please give (Child's Name) wisdom. Thank You that You give generously to everyone without finding fault. Help (Child's Name) to believe and not doubt, and give him/her singleness of mind and stability in all that he/she does. Help him/her to be decisive and to make good decisions. (James 1:5-8)

**Day 12:** Please let (Child's Name) light shine before others, that they might see his/her good deeds and praise You, our Father in heaven. (Matthew 5:16)

- Day 13:** I pray that (Child's Name) will enjoy good health and that all will go well with him/her. (3 John 2)
- Day 14:** Please give (Child's Name) and his/her siblings endurance, encouragement and a spirit of unity as he/she follows Christ Jesus, so that with one heart and mouth they may glorify You, precious Lord. (Rom. 15:5-6)
- Day 15:** Please teach (Child's Name) to sow generously, that he/she might also reap generously. Let his/her giving be marked by cheerfulness rather than by reluctance, and supply all his/her needs so that he/she will abound in every good work. (2 Corinthians 9:6-8)
- Day 16:** Thank You that (Child's Name) is Your workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which You prepared in advance for him/her to do. (Ephesians 2:10)
- Day 17:** Please fill (Child's Name) with the knowledge of Your will through all spiritual wisdom and understanding, that he/she might live a life worthy of You, Lord, and please You in every way. (Col. 1:9-10)
- Day 18:** Please protect (Child's Name), because he/she worships You. My God, save (Child's Name), Your servant who trusts in You. (Psalm 86:2)
- Day 19:** Please let (Child's Name) be kind and compassionate to others, forgiving them just as in Christ God forgave him/her. (Ephesians 4:32)
- Day 20:** Please remove the veil from (Child's Name) eyes so that he/she can see the light of the gospel. Shine Your light in his/her heart to give him/her the light of the knowledge of Your glory in the face of Christ. (2 Corinthians 4:4-6)
- Day 21:** Please show (Child's Name) that Your way is perfect and Your Word is flawless. Be his/her shield as he/she takes refuge in You. (2 Samuel 22:31)
- Day 22:** Please set a guard over (Child's Name) mouth, O Lord; keep watch over his/her lips. Don't let his/her heart be drawn to what is evil or allow his/her to take part in wicked deeds. (Psalm 141:3-4)
- Day 23:** No matter what (Child's Name) is planning in his/her heart, let Your purpose prevail in his/her life. (Proverbs 19:21)
- Day 24:** Please do not let anything separate (Child's Name) from Your love. When trouble, hardship, persecution, danger or any need arises, let (Child's Name) remember that we are "more than conquerors" and that nothing can separate him/her from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Rom. 8:35-39)
- Day 25:** Please don't let (Child's Name) be wise in his/her own eyes; rather, cause him/her to fear You and shun evil. You have promised that this will bring health to his/her body and nourishment to his/her bones. (Pr. 3:7-8)
- Day 26:** Please lead (Child's Name) not into temptation, but deliver him/her from the evil one. (Mt. 6:13)
- Day 27:** Please let (Child's Name) use his/her gift to serve others, faithfully administering Your grace in its various forms, so that in all things You will be praised and receive glory. (1 Peter 4:10-11)

- Day 28:** Please let (Child’s Name) be quick to confess sin, knowing that You are faithful and just, and that You will forgive his/her sins and purify him/her from all unrighteousness. Don’t let him/her get bogged down by his/her past mistakes; rather, remind him/her that he/she is a new creation in Christ, that the old has gone and the new has come! (1 John 1:9 / 2 Corinthians 5:17)
- Day 29:** Please fulfill every good purpose in (Child’s Name) life and every act prompted by his/her faith, so that the name of our Lord Jesus Christ may be glorified in his/her life. (2 Thessalonians 1:11-12)
- Day 30:** Please surround (Child’s Name) with friends who will sharpen him/her as iron sharpens iron. (Pr. 27:17)
- Day 31:** Please do not let any unwholesome talk come out of (Child’s Name) mouth, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen. (Ephesians 4:29)
- Day 32:** Please cause (Child’s Name) to obey his/her teachers and coaches and submit to their authority. Let him/her know that these people keep watch over him/her and that You will hold them accountable for the job they do. Show (Child’s Name) that when he/she obeys his/her teachers and coaches and makes their work a joy instead of a burden, the end result will be to his/her advantage. (Hebrews 13:17)
- Day 33:** Please don’t let us exasperate (Child’s Name); instead, help us bring him/her up in the training and instruction of the Lord. (Ephesians 6:1-3)
- Day 34:** Thank You for the special gift you’ve given (Child’s Name). Show him/her how his/her gift differs from the gifts you have given others, and let him/her be generous, diligent, and cheerful in using it. (Romans 12:6-8)
- Day 35:** Please let (Child’s Name) acknowledge Your ownership of his/her resources, knowing that everything he/she has comes from Your hand. Let (Child’s Name) always look to You to meet all his/her needs, according to Your glorious riches in Christ Jesus. (1 Chronicles 29:14 / Philippians 4:19)
- Day 36:** Please be (Child’s Name) Lord and God. Teach him/her what is best for him/her and direct him/her in the way he/she should go. (Isaiah 48:17)
- Day 37:** Please put people in (Child’s Name) life who will gently instruct him/her; and grant him/her repentance leading to a knowledge of the truth. (2 Timothy 2:25)
- Day 38:** Please show (Child’s Name) that all Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting, and training in righteousness. (2 Timothy 3:16)
- Day 39:** Above all, let (Child’s Name) love others deeply, because love covers over a multitude of sins. Let (Child’s Name) use whatever gift he/she has received to serve others, faithfully administering your grace in its various forms. Let him/her serve with the strength You provide, so that in all things You, O Lord, will get the credit and the glory. (1 Peter 4:8-11)

**Day 40:** Place a hedge of protection and blessing around (Child's Name) and everything he/she has.  
(Job 1:10)

**Day 41:** I pray that (Child's Name) identity will be firmly rooted and established in Christ's love, and that (Child's Name) may have power, together with all the saints, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, and to know this love that surpasses knowledge – that he/she may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God. (Ephesians 3:17-19)

**Day 42:** Please cause (Child's Name) to offer his/her body as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to You, Lord. (Romans 12:1)

**Day 43:** Please let (Child's Name) flee the evil desires of youth and pursue righteousness, faith, love and peace, and let him/her enjoy the companionship of those who call on You out of a pure heart.  
(2 Timothy 2:22)

**Day 44:** Please let (Child's Name) hold on to wisdom and good sense and not let them out of his/her sight.  
(Proverbs 3:21)

**Day 45:** When (Child's Name) is set upon by bullies or assaulted by other wickedness, please help him/her and deliver him/her. Deliver him/her from the wicked and save him/her, because he/she takes refuge in You. (Ps. 37:40)

**Day 46:** I pray that (Child's Name) will always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks him/her to give the reason for the hope he/she has, and cause him/her to speak with gentleness and respect.  
(1 Pe. 3:15)

**Day 47:** Please enable (Child's Name) to be strong and courageous. Don't let him/her get frightened or discouraged, but let him/her know that You will be with him/her wherever he/she goes. (Joshua 1:9)

**Day 48:** Please watch over (Child's Name) life. Do not slumber or sleep, but keep him/her from all harm. Watch over his/her life, his/her coming and going, both now and forevermore. (Psalm 121:3-8)

**Day 49:** You know the plans You have for (Child's Name), plans to prosper him/her and not to harm him/her, plans to give him/her hope and a future. Cause (Child's Name) to call upon You and come and pray to You, and then listen to him/her, O Lord. Let him/her seek you with all his/her heart, and find You when he/she does seek You. (Jeremiah 29:11-13)

**Day 50:** Pray that (Child's Name) will put his/her trust in You and never be shaken. (Psalm 125:1)

**Day 51:** Please let (Child's Name) listen to his/her father's instruction and never forsake his/her mother's teaching. Let (Child's Name) love wisdom and therefore bring joy to our hearts.  
(Proverbs 1:8 / 29:3)

- Day 52:** Please let (Child's Name) be careful and wise in how he/she lives, making the most of every opportunity and understanding Your will for his/her life. (Ephesians 5:15-17)
- Day 53:** Please help us to train (Child's Name) in the way he/she should go, so that when he/she is old he/she will not turn from it. (Proverbs 22:6)
- Day 54:** I pray that (Child's Name) would show proper respect to everyone. Let him/her love his/her brothers and sisters in Christ, fear You, and honor those in authority over him/her. (1 Peter 2:17)
- Day 55:** Please cause (Child's Name) and his/her siblings to be devoted to one another in brotherly love, honoring one another above themselves. (Romans 12:10)
- Day 56:** Please open (Child's Name) eyes and turn him/her from darkness to light and from the power of Satan to God, so that he/she may receive forgiveness of sins and a place among those who are sanctified by faith in Christ. (Acts 26:18)
- Day 57:** Please let (Child's Name) heart be good soil, that he/she might hear Your word, retain it, and persevere to produce a crop of godly character and effectiveness for Your kingdom. Don't let Satan snatch Your word from (Child's Name) heart, and don't let the worries, riches, or pleasures of this life choke Your word and make it unfruitful in his/her life. - Day 58:** Please let (Child's Name) use his/her gifts for the common good, recognizing how he/she fits into the body of Christ and using his/her special abilities to build up and compliment others. (1 Corinthians 12:7-26)
- Day 59:** May (Child's Name) never be ashamed of the gospel, but let him/her recognize that it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes. (Romans 1:6)
- Day 60:** Please do not let (Child's Name) look at the things man looks at, but let him/her see the world through Your eyes and respond to it with Your wisdom and Your love. (1 Samuel 16:7)
- Day 61:** Please let (Child's Name) worship and serve others in love. (Galatians 5:13)
- Day 62:** Please enable (Child's Name) to do the things that show he/she has really changed his/her heart and life. (Matthew 3:8)
- Day 63:** Please let (Child's Name) lie down and sleep in peace. (Psalm 4:8)
- Day 64:** Please help (Child's Name) to take captive every thought he/she has to make it obedient to Christ. (2 Corinthians 10:5)
- Day 65:** Please let (Child's Name) be filled with the joy given by the Holy Spirit. Let (Child's Name) be joyful always, pray continually, and give thanks in all circumstances, for this is Your will for his/her in Christ Jesus. (1 Thessalonians 1:6 / 5:16-18)
- Day 66:** Please do not let (Child's Name) be led astray by drugs and alcohol. (Proverbs 20:1)
- Day 67:** Please bless and keep (Child's Name), so that he/she will not walk in the counsel of the wicked or stand in the way of sinners or sit in the seat of mockers. (Psalm 1:1)

**Day 68:** Please teach (Child's Name) to obey us in everything, for this pleases You, Lord. Do not let us say or do anything that would embitter or discourage him/her. (Colossians 3:20-21)

**Day 69:** Please work in (Child's Name) so he/she will think and act according to Your good purpose. (Phil. 2:13)

**Day 70:** Thank You that You have put Your angels in charge of (Child's Name) to watch over him/her wherever he/she goes. (Psalm 91:11)

**Day 71:** Please cause (Child's Name) to delight in You, and give him/her the desires of his/her heart. Let him/her commit his/her way to You, trusting in You as You make his/her righteousness shine like the dawn. (Psalm 37:4-5)

**Day 72:** Please let (Child's Name) trust You all the time and tell You all his/her problems, because You are his/her protection. (Psalm 62:8)

**Day 73:** Please let (Child's Name) delight in Your law, and let him/her meditate on it day and night, so that whatever he/she does will prosper. (Psalm 1:1-3)

**Day 74:** Please teach (Child's Name) how to live a holy life. Let being with You fill him/her with joy; at Your right hand let (Child's Name) find pleasure forever. (Psalm 16:11)

**Day 75:** Please cause (Child's Name) to follow You, and make him/her a fisher of people. (Matthew 4:19)

**Day 76:** Please give (Child's Name) wisdom and understanding. Do not let him/her forget Your words or swerve from them. Cause him/her to love wisdom and to value it above all worldly desires and accomplishments. (Proverbs 4:5-7)

**Day 77:** Whatever (Child's Name) does, let him/her work at it with all his/her heart, as working for You, not for people. (Colossians 3:23)

**Day 78:** May (Child's Name) sin find him/her out, so that he/she will be drawn back to You, Lord, for forgiveness and Your gracious blessing of a new beginning. (Numbers 32:23)

**Day 79:** Please let (Child's Name) be wise in what is good and innocent in what is evil. (Romans 16:19)

**Day 80:** Please show (Child's Name) how to use his/her gifts and talents wisely; being faithful with the abilities You have given him/her. (Matthew 25:21)

**Day 81:** Please let (Child's Name) seek friendship with You rather than with the world, remembering that anyone who chooses to be a friend of the world becomes Your enemy. (James 4:4)

**Day 82:** Please let (Child's Name) love his/her siblings, for love comes from You. Remind him/her that everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God, and that whoever loves God must also love his/her brother. (1 John 4:7, 21)

**Day 83:** Lord, teach (Child's Name) perseverance in all he/she does, and help him/her especially to run with perseverance the race marked out for him/her. (Heb. 12:1)

**Day 84:** Please help (Child's Name) to submit to You, O God, and to resist the devil. Make the devil flee from (Child's Name) as he/she draws near to You. (James 4:7-8)

**Day 85:** Please give (Child's Name) the mind of Christ. (1 Corinthians 2:16)

**Day 86:** Please keep (Child's Name) as the apple of Your eye; hide him/her in the shadow of Your wings from the wicked who assail him/her, from the mortal enemies who surround him/her. (Psalm 17:8-9)

**Day 87:** Please bless (Child's Name) with friends, and let him/her be a friend to the friendless, since “two are better than one...if one falls down, his/her friend can help him/her up. But pity the man who falls and has no one to help him/her up!” (Ecclesiastes 4:9-10)

**Day 88:** I pray that (Child's Name) will do everything without arguing or complaining. (Philippians 2:14)

**Day 89:** Please let (Child's Name) stand strong. Do not let anything change him/her. Help him/her to always give himself fully to Your work, because his/her work in the Lord is never wasted. (1 Corinthians 15:58)

**Day 90:** Please fulfill Your purpose for (Child's Name); do not abandon the work of Your hands. (Psalm 138:8)

**Day 91:** Please give (Child's Name) a grateful heart, and equip him/her to rejoice, to pray and to give thanks in all circumstances. (1 Thessalonians 5:16-18)

**Day 92:** You promise to tend Your flock like a shepherd. Gather (Child's Name) like a lamb in Your arms and carry him/her close to Your heart. And, just as You promise to gently lead those that have young, teach us, as parents, how to lead and guide and care for (Child's Name). (Isaiah 40:11)

**Day 93:** I pray that (Child's Name) will continue to live in Christ, rooted and built up in Him, strengthened in the faith as he/she was taught, and overflowing with thankfulness. (Colossians 2:6-7)

**Day 94:** I pray that (Child's Name) would confess with his/her mouth that Jesus is Lord, and he/she would believe in his/her heart that You have raised Christ from the dead. Cause (Child's Name) to call on your name, Lord, and save him/her. (Romans 10:9, 13)



**Day 95:** Please teach (Child's Name) to know Your commands and obey them, thereby demonstrating his/her love for You. Let him/her know Your promised reward; that “he/she who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I too will love him/her and show myself to him/her.” Love him/her, and show Yourself to him/her, Lord. (John 14:21)

**Day 96:** Please counsel (Child's Name), Lord. Instruct him/her, even during the night. Make known to him/her the path of life and fill him/her with joy in Your presence. (Psalm 16:7, 11)

**Day 97:** Please let (Child's Name) trust in You with all his/her heart. Don't let him/her rely on his/her own understanding, but cause him/her to acknowledge You in all his/her ways, and make his/her paths straight. (Pr.3:5-6)

**Day 98:** Please let (Child's Name) worship You and serve You with gladness. (Psalm 100:2)

**Day 99:** Please cause (Child's Name) to make every effort to add to his/her faith, goodness; and to goodness, knowledge; and to knowledge, self-control; and to self-control, perseverance; and to perseverance, godliness; and to godliness, kindness, and to kindness, love. Let (Child's Name) possess these qualities in increasing measure, so that he/she will be effective and productive in his/her knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. (2 Peter 1:5-8)

**Day 100:** Please let (Child's Name) open his/her arms to the poor and extend his/her hands to the needy. (Proverbs 31:20)

“You can pray for your children’s future with hope and confidence, knowing that God loves them and has a special plan for each of their lives.”

**Day 101:** Please let (Child's Name) take refuge in You and be glad; let him/her ever sing for joy. Spread Your protection over (Child's Name) that he/she may rejoice in You. (Psalm 5:11)

**Day 102:** Please let (Child's Name) grow as Jesus did, in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and men. (Luke 2:52)

**Day 103:** Please hem (Child's Name) in – behind and before; place Your hand upon him/her so that wherever he/she goes and whatever he/she does, he/she will be accompanied by your presence. (Psalm 139:5-10)

**Day 104:** Please shape (Child's Name) into a friend who loves at all times. (Proverbs 17:17)

**Day 105:** Please let (Child's Name) and his/her siblings be encouraged and knit together with strong ties of love. Let them have the rich experience of knowing Christ with real certainty and clear understanding. (Colossians 2:2)

**Day 106:** Please help (Child's Name) to see that although he/she may have small troubles for awhile now; they are helping him/her gain an eternal glory that is much greater than the troubles. Set his/her eyes not on what he/she can see but on what he/she cannot see because what he/she sees will last only a short time, but what he/she cannot see will last forever. (2 Corinthians 5:17-18)

**Day 107:** Please let (Child's Name) keep our commands and never forsake our teaching. Let him/her bind them upon his/her heart forever and fasten them around his/her neck. When he/she walks, let our teaching guide him/her; when he/she sleeps, let it watch over him/her; when he/she wakes, let our words speak to him/her. Let (Child's Name) regard our instruction and our commands as a guiding lamp; let him/her welcome our correction as the way to life. (Proverbs 6:20-23)

**Day 108:** Thank You that no eye has seen, no ear has heard, no mind can conceive what You have prepared for (Child's Name) because he/she loves You. Cause him/her to be willing to wait on You, and act on his/her behalf. (1 Corinthians 2:9 / Isaiah 64:4)

**Day 109:** Please keep (Child's Name) life free from the love of money and let him/her be content with what he/she has, knowing that You, O Lord, will never leave him/her or forsake him/her. (Hebrews 13:5)

**Day 110:** Please teach (Child's Name), O Lord, to follow Your decrees. Give him/her understanding to keep Your law and obey it with all his/her heart. Direct (Child's Name) in the path of Your commands, and let him/her find delight there. Turn his/her heart toward Your statutes and not toward selfish gain. (Psalm 119:33-36)

**Day 111:** Thank You for loving (Child's Name) so much that You gave Your one and only Son, that when (Child's Name) believes in Him he/she will not perish but have eternal life. (John 3:16)

**Day 112:** Please do not let (Child's Name) merely listen to the Word, and so deceive himself. Let him/her do what it says. (James 1:22)

**Day 113:** Please cause (Child's Name) to be diligent in developing his/her gifts and talents so that he/she will become "skilled in his/her work" and "serve before kings," using his/her abilities to fulfill Your purposes. (Proverbs 22:29)

**Day 114:** Please let (Child's Name) become blameless and pure, a child of God without fault in a crooked and depraved generation, and let (Child's Name) shine like a star in the universe as he/she holds out the Word of life. (Philippians 2:15-16)

**Day 115:** Please instill in (Child's Name) a soul that 'followeth hard after thee,' one that clings passionately to you. (Psalm 63:8)

**Day 116:** Please motivate (Child's Name) to serve wholeheartedly, as if he/she were serving You, not people, and remind his/her that You will reward everyone for whatever good they do. (Ephesians 6:7-8)

**Day 117:** Thank You for showing compassion to us, I pray that (Child's Name) would follow Your example, being compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in love. (Psalm 103:8)

**Day 118:** Please make (Child's Name) self controlled and alert. His enemy the devil prowls around like roaring lion looking for someone to devour. Help him/her to resist him/her and stand firm in his/her faith. (1 Peter 5:8-9)

**Day 119:** Lord, You are faithful. Please strengthen and protect (Child's Name) from the evil one. (2 Thess. 3:3)

“God rarely fulfills your expectations when you pray. He tends to exceed them!”

**Day 120:** Please cause (Child’s Name) to put his/her trust in You, O Lord, let him/her say “You are my God. My times and my days are in Your hands.” (Psalm 31:14-15)

**Day 121:** Please let (Child’s Name) use his/her gifts and talents for Your glory. (1 Corinthians 10:31)

**Day 122:** Please let the light of Your face shine upon (Child’s Name). Fill his/her heart with joy, and let him/her lie down and sleep in peace. (Psalm 4:6-8)

**Day 123:** Thank You Lord that You have special plans for (Child’s Name) and have set him/her apart for Your work even before he/she was born by calling him/her through Your grace. (Galatians 1:15)

**Day 124:** Please don’t let (Child’s Name) exclude his/her peers or participate in gossip, since a gossip causes trouble and separates close friends. (Proverbs 16:28)

**Day 125:** Please do not permit (Child’s Name) to be quarrelsome; instead, cause him/her to be gentle, patient and humble. (2 Timothy 2:22-24)

**Day 126:** Please let us learn self discipline as a gift. Let (Child’s Name) recognize that when we discipline him/her, it means that we love him/her and that he/she belongs to our family – just as You discipline those You love, those You accept as Your sons and daughters. Let (Child’s Name) respect us when we discipline him/her, realizing that we are doing our best and that we ourselves are submitting to Your discipline, which is for our good. (Hebrews 12:5-10)

**Day 127:** Please cause (Child’s Name) to be wise in the way he/she acts, making the most of every opportunity. When he/she talks, help him/her to always be kind and pleasant so he/she will be able to answer everyone in the way he/she should. (Colossians 4:5-6)

**Day 128:** Thank You for beginning a good work in (Child’s Name), and that You will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus. (Philippians 1:6)

**Day 129:** I pray that (Child’s Name) will have greater understanding in his/her heart so he/she will know the hope to which You have called us and that he/she will know how rich and glorious are the blessings God has promised His holy people. (Ephesians 1:18)

**Day 130:** Please cause (Child’s Name) to obey his/her parents. Let him/her honor his/her father and mother, so that all may go well with him/her and that he/she may enjoy a long life on earth. (Ephesians 6:1-3)

**Day 131:** Please let Your Spirit rest on (Child’s Name). Give him/her the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and power, the Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the Lord – that he/she might delight in the fear of the Lord. Don’t let (Child’s Name) judge by what he/she sees with his/her eyes, or decide by what he/she hears with his/her ears, but let him/her act with righteousness, justice, and faith. (Isaiah 11:2-5)

**Day 132:** Please let the Word of Christ dwell in (Child’s Name) richly as he/she and his/her peers teach and admonish one another with all wisdom, and as he/she sings psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs with gratitude in his/her heart toward God. (Colossians 3:16)

**Day 133:** Whenever (Child's Name) opens his/her mouth, give him/her the words to say so that he/she will fearlessly make known the mystery of the gospel. (Ephesians 6:19)

**Day 134:** Please give (Child's Name) a wise and discerning heart so that he/she can distinguish between right and wrong. (1 Kings 3:9,12)

**Day 135:** Please teach (Child's Name) that if he/she wants to become great he/she must be a servant. If he/she wants to be first, he/she must be last- just as Jesus did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life as a ransom for many. (Matthew 20:26)

**Day 136:** Please fill (Child's Name) with Your Holy Spirit, that he/she might bear the Spirit's fruit: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. (Galatians 5:22-23)

**Day 137:** Please prepare (Child's Name) mind for action. Let him/her be self-controlled, with his/her hope set fully on the grace to be given him/her when Jesus Christ is revealed. (1 Peter 1:13)

**Day 139:** Please show (Child's Name) how to put off his/her old self, which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires, and make his/her new in the attitude of his/her mind. Cause him/her to put off falsehood and speak truthfully, and to refrain from sin when he/she is angry. Above all, do not let (Child's Name) do anything that would give the devil a foothold in his/her life. (Ephesians 4:22-27)

**Day 140:** Please let (Child's Name) love others with the love that comes from You. And as he/she loves, live in him/her Lord, and make Your love complete in him/her. (1 John 4:7,12)

**Day 141:** Please let (Child's Name) be glad for all You are planning for him/her. Let him/her be patient in trouble and prayerful always. (Romans 12:12)

**Day 142:** Please teach (Child's Name) to realize that each day is a gift from You; help him/her to spend them as he/she should. (Psalm 90:12)

**Day 143:** Let (Child's Name) know that he/she belongs to You. (Romans 14:7-9)

**Day 144:** Create in (Child's Name) a pure heart, O God, and let that purity of heart be shown in his/her actions. (Psalm 51:10)

**Day 145:** Please make Your Word a lamp to (Child's Name)'s feet and a light for his/her path. (Ps. 119:105)

**Day 146:** Please equip (Child's Name) with everything good for doing Your will. (Hebrews 13:21)

- Day 147:** When (Child's Name) is confronted with grief, uncertainty, fear, or pressure, remind him/her of Your promise that he/she does not need to fear, for You are with him/her; he/she does not need to be dismayed, for You are his/her God and You will strengthen him/her and help him/her. You will uphold him/her with Your right hand. (Isaiah 41:10)
- Day 148:** Please let (Child's Name) praise You with all his/her heart and soul and never forget Your benefits. Forgive his/her sins, heal his/her diseases, redeem his/her life, and crown him/her with love and compassion. Satisfy his/her desires with good things. Let (Child's Name) know that from everlasting to everlasting, Your love is with those who fear You, and Your righteousness will be with his/her children's children as they keep Your commandments and remember to obey Your precepts. (Psalm 103:1-5, 17-18)
- Day 149:** Please let (Child's Name) be willing to forgive not seven times, but in unlimited amounts. Let him/her have pity on others, acting with patience and mercy in all things. (Matthew 18:21-35)
- Day 150:** Help (Child's Name) run from sex sin. No other sin affects the body as this one does. (1 Cor. 6:18) For You want (Child's Name) to be holy and pure, and to keep clear of all sexual sin so that he/she will marry in holiness and honor – not in lustful passion as the heathen do, in their ignorance of God and His ways. (1 Thess. 4:3-5)
- Day 151:** Please do not give (Child's Name) a spirit of timidity, but a spirit of power, of love and of self-discipline. (2 Timothy 1:7)
- Day 152:** Please do not let anyone lead (Child's Name) astray. Cause him/her to do what is righteous rather than what is sinful. Thank You for sending Your Son to destroy the devil's work. (1 John 3:7-8)
- Day 153:** Please clothe (Child's Name) with Your full armor so that he/she can take his/her stand against the devil's schemes. Help him/her to stand firm, with the belt of truth and the breastplate of righteousness. Fit his/her feet with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace. Give (Child's Name) the shield of faith, with which he/she can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. Place the helmet of salvation on his/her head and the sword of the Spirit, which is Your word, in his/her hands. Finally, teach him/her to pray, and to be alert. (Ephesians 6:11-18)
- Day 154:** Please let (Child's Name) do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but in humility consider others better than him/her. Let him/her look not only to his/her own interests, but also to the interests of others, and let his/her attitude be the same as that of Christ Jesus. (Philippians 2:3-5)
- Day 155:** Please comfort (Child's Name) in all his/her troubles, so that he/she may comfort those in any trouble with the comfort he/she has received from You, precious Lord. (2 Corinthians 1:4)
- Day 156:** Please cause (Child's Name) to fear You, since this is the beginning of wisdom. Cause (Child's Name) to know You, and to understand Your perspective on any situation. Add years to his/her life, and give him/her the reward of the wise. (Proverbs 9:10-12)
- Day 157:** Please help (Child's Name) to be alert, standing firm in his/her faith, having courage, and doing everything in love. (1 Corinthians 16:13-14)
- Day 158:** Please let (Child's Name) sing of Your great love forever; let him/her make known Your faithfulness through all generations. (Psalm 89:1)

**Day 159:** Please help (Child's Name) to stay away from the love of money. Instead, cause him/her to serve God, have faith, love, patience, and gentleness. (1 Timothy 6:10-11)

**Day 160:** Please bestow on (Child's Name) all the goodness You have stored up for him/her because he/she fears You. When his/her feelings are hurt, be his/her shelter and his/her refuge, and keep him/her safe from the strife of unkind words. (Psalm 31:19-20)

**Day 161:** Let (Child's Name) make every effort to win Your praise, rather than seeking the approval of his/her peers. Show (Child's Name) that the fear of man is a trap, but he/she who trusts in You will be kept safe. (John 5:44 / Proverbs 29:25)

**Day 162:** As we pray for (Child's Name), do not let him/her be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, let (Child's Name) always remember to present his/her requests to You. And let Your peace, which transcends all understanding, guard his/her heart and mind in Christ Jesus. (Philippians 4:6-7)

**Day 163:** Please fill (Child's Name) with the knowledge of Your will through all spiritual wisdom and understanding, so that he/she may live a life worthy of You and may please You in every way; bearing fruit in every good work and growing in the knowledge of You, Lord. (Colossians 1:9-10)

**Day 164:** Please don't let (Child's Name) be arrogant or put his/her hope in wealth, which is so uncertain, but let him/her put his/her hope in You. Let him/her enjoy all that You have provided for him/her, and cause him/her to be rich in good deeds, being generous and always willing to share. Let (Child's Name) lay up treasure for himself as a firm foundation for the coming age, so that he/she can take hold of the life that is truly life. (1 Timothy 6:17-19)

**Day 165:** Please let (Child's Name) be diligent, O Lord, and satisfy all his/her desires. (Proverbs 13:4)

**Day 166:** Please let (Child's Name) dwell in the shelter of the Most High and rest in the shadow of the Almighty. Be his/her refuge, his/her fortress, his/her covering, and his/her shield. Do not let him/her fear the terror of the night, nor any type of plague or sickness. Do not let any harm or disaster come near (Child's Name). Command Your angels to guard him/her in all his/her ways and keep him/her from hurting himself. When he/she calls on You, answer him/her. (Phil. 1:9-11)

**Day 168:** Please let (Child's Name) trust in You with all his/her heart and lean not on his/her own understanding. In all his/her ways and in everything he/she does, let him/her acknowledge Your lordship and Your presence, and direct his/her paths in his/her education, relationships, and in his/her walk with You. (Proverbs 3:5-6)

**Day 169:** Let love and faithfulness never leave (Child's Name), but bind these twin virtues around his/her neck and write them on the tablet of his/her heart. (Proverbs 3:3)

**Day 170:** May (Child's Name) always be strong and courageous in his/her character and in his/her actions. (Deut. 31:6)

**Day 171:** May (Child's Name) grow to find Your Word more precious than pure gold and sweeter than honey from the comb. (Psalm 19:10)

**Day 172:** Help (Child's Name) know that everything You say is right and true, for You hates lies and every kind of deception. Telling the truth will give (Child's Name) great satisfaction. (Prov. 8:7;12:14)

**Day 173 :** Grant that (Child's Name) may learn responsibility, for each should carry his/her own load. (Gal. 6:5)

**Day 174:** Please cultivate in (Child's Name) the ability to show true humility toward all. (Titus 3:2)

**Day 175:** We have prayed for (Child's Name), and You have granted us what we have asked. So now we give him/her to You, Lord. For his/her whole life he/she will be given over to the Lord. (1 Samuel 1:27-28)

**Day 176:** Please let (Child's Name) live in harmony, being sympathetic, compassionate, and humble. Don't let (Child's Name) repay evil with evil or insult with insult, but with blessing. (1 Peter 3:8-9)

**Day 179:** Please show (Child's Name) that he/she is fearfully and wonderfully made, and that Your works are wonderful. Teach him/her that he/she is precious in Your sight, and that You love him/her. (Psalm 139:14 / Isaiah 43:4)

**Day 180:** Please keep (Child's Name) from the snares the enemy has laid for him/her, from the traps of the evildoers. Let the wicked fall into their own nets, while he/she passes by in safety. (Psalm 141:9-10)

**Pray that this will be your child's prayer:**

Lord, just tell me what to do and I will do it. As long as I live, I'll wholeheartedly obey. Make me walk along the right paths for I know how delightful they really are. Help me to prefer obedience to making money! Turn me away from wanting any other plan than Yours. Revive my heart toward You. Reassure me that Your promises are for me, for I trust and revere You. (Psalm 119:33-38)
