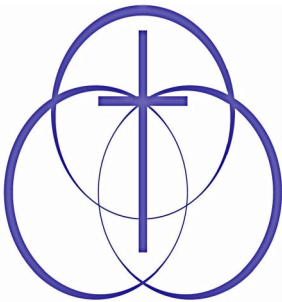

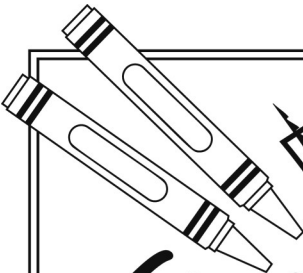

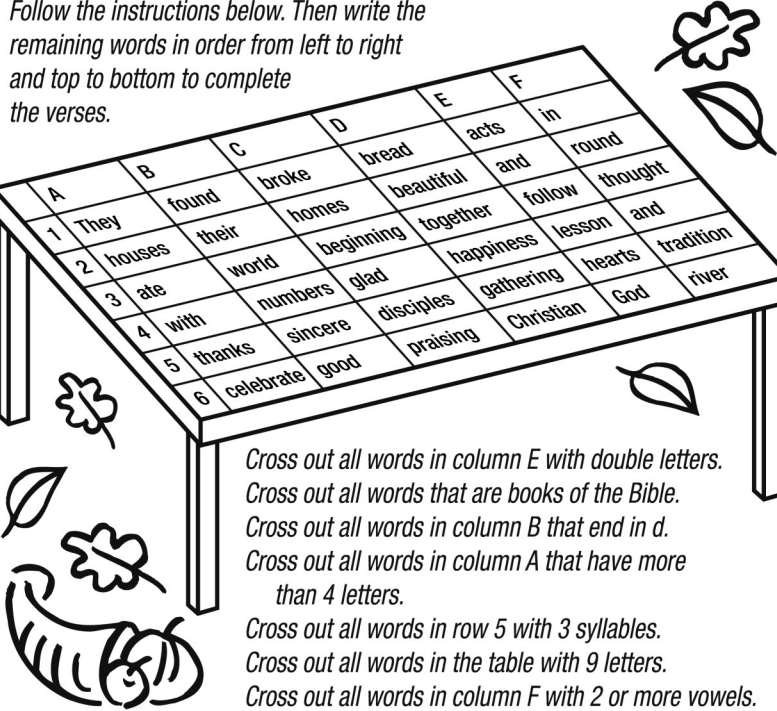


PUZZLE
