From the Pastor...

During the Easter season, we celebrate and rejoice in the salvation God has given us in the death, burial, and resurrection of His Son, Jesus Christ. The resurrection of Jesus was not merely a spiritual thing. He did not come back as a ghost (Luke 24:36-43). Neither was the resurrection merely a metaphor. The resurrection of Jesus was a bodily resurrection in which his mortal body was raised and transformed into an immortal body incapable of ever dying again. It takes faith in a real bodily resurrection to deliver us from the fear of a real bodily death and to give us a sure and certain hope!



Nonetheless, the power of the resurrection is not something we have to wait for at the second coming of Jesus. Rom 8:11 says, "If the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, he who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit who dwells in you." This is not talking about life after death or life in immortal resurrected bodies; this is talking about living a holy and righteous life in the power of the Holy Spirit in the here and now. Just look at the sixth chapter of Romans!

"What shall we say then? Are we to continue in sin that grace may abound? By no means! How can we who died to sin still live in it? Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life." Rom 6:1-4

This is not something that we could ever do in our own strength. But by faith in the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus, we have the power to live in newness of life even now in our mortal bodies. We also have the promise and hope of a new immortal body like the one Jesus was raised to when he returns in glory. This is Christian hope! It is hope for a bright tomorrow, but it is also a hope that gives us strength and power today.




