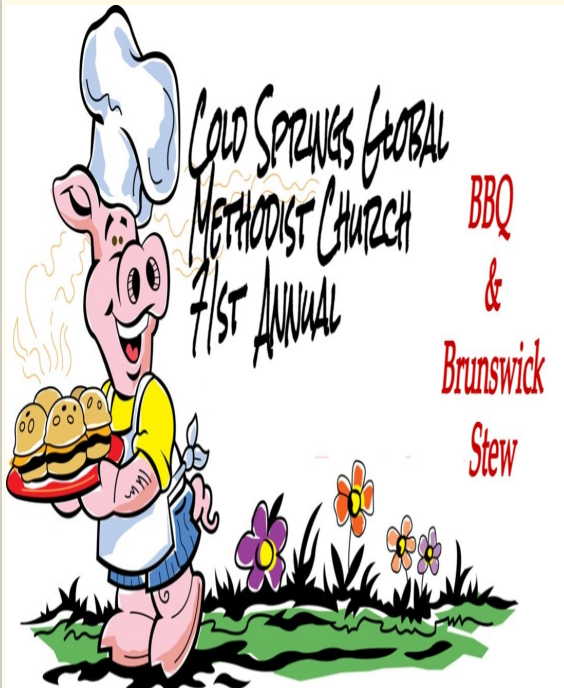

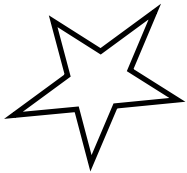

INDEPENDENCE DAY PARADE



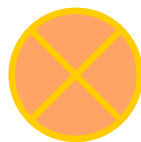
