In this season of Advent and Christmas, we're not merely celebrating the birth of a great religious leader among others. Jesus of Nazareth, indeed, was a great shepherd-leader. He was a mighty prophet and a profound teacher. He was the messiah, the anointed savior-king of Israel. Yet, he was and is and always will be so much more!



In fulfillment of Isaiah 40:3, John the Baptist was called to "prepare the

way of the Lord" and to "make straight in the desert a highway for our God" (ESV; see also Luke 3). Further into the context Isaiah 40:10-11 goes further and says: "Behold, the Lord your God comes with might, . . ." and "He will tend his flock like a shepherd; he will gather the lambs in his arms; he will carry them in his bosom, and gently lead those that are with young" (see also Ezk 34:11-16). During advent and Christmas, we celebrate not just the birth of a great spiritual leader; we celebrate the *incarnation* of the eternally divine, one and only, unique Son of God; God himself who became fully human "for us and for our salvation" (Nicene Creed).

Christmas reminds that that we live not in a world of impersonal forces, callous and cold, where we are all "just dust in the wind." We are creatures created in the image of God, significant enough and loved so much that God the Father sent his Son to become one of us, to redeem and to restore us (John 3:16). At Christmas we celebrate that the God of love came Himself to give the world a renewed hope and to bring back everlasting peace and joy. Now that is something to really celebrate!

May your Advent and Christmas season be merry and bright in the light of God's goodness and grace in Jesus Christ!




CHURCH PARKING LOT ENTRANCE
