An exodus is a way out—an exit. It's good to know where the exit is!

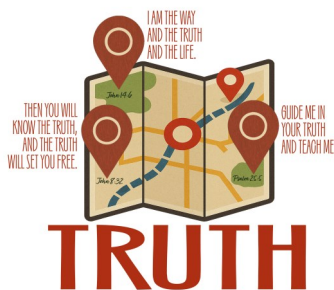

Cold Springs will be handing out water bottles with CSGMC labels and "cold springs water".

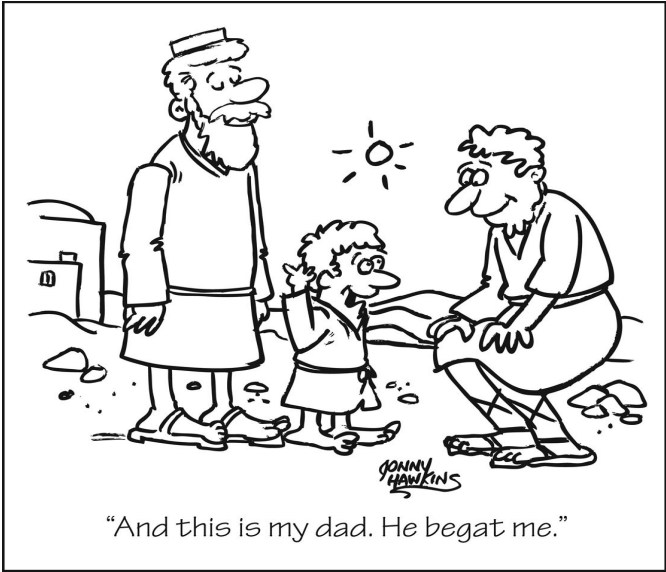
