

From the Pastor...

"And behold, I am sending the promise of my Father upon you. But stay in the city until you are clothed with power from on high." Luke 24:49

After his resurrection, Jesus instructed the apostles and disciples to expect to receive the promise of the Father, "power from on high," soon. Jesus was talking about the promised outpouring of the Holy Spirit found in the Old Testament scriptures. Acts 1:8 clarifies that the "power from on high" would be the Holy Spirit.

Before the day of Pentecost as recorded in Acts 2, the Holy Spirit was only given to certain people at certain times, but not to all of God's people. The promise was that in the last days God would give his Spirit to all His people to empower them for obedience and bold witness to the world. In Ezekiel 36:27 we find the promise of God that he would put his very own Spirit in each believer to transform their character and to empower them for faithful obedience to God's law (compare Rom 8:4). In Joel 2:28-29 we see the promise of the Spirit for all God's people, male and female, to be equipped with gifts and signs to accompany their witness. We also find the promise of the Father in Isaiah 44:1-5 and many other places.

Under the New Covenant, all of God's people, each believer, is filled with the Spirit of God when they believe. The Spirit is power for obedience and for bold witness to the goodness of God revealed in Jesus Christ. But the Spirit is not merely a power source, the Holy Spirit is a person. He is the Spirit of the Father and the Son. Indeed, the Spirit is the Spirit of the Living Lord living in and through all who believe. God gives us His Spirit, that we "may be filled with all the fullness of God" (Eph 3:19).
