



From the Pastor...

The Gospel of John begins with the words "In the beginning," quite intentionally referencing the story of creation in Genesis. John wants us to understand right from the start that the story of Jesus is about a new beginning for the world. The One who was "with God and was God" and involved in the original creation of all things (1:1-3), and Who became human in the person of Jesus of Nazareth, is the one whose mission it was to make all things new. It was his mission to bring about a new creation, a new heaven and earth (Rev 21:1).



On the cross, according to John, Jesus' final words before he died were, "It is finished." (19:30). I believe there's an intentional allusion here to Genesis 2:2 that tells us "By the seventh day God had finished the work" of creation and rested on the seventh. Jesus, rested in the tomb on the seventh day and on the first day of the week rose in glory with the dawning light of new creation, a new beginning for the world, and new birth through the Holy Spirit for all who believe! When Jesus first met with his disciples after the resurrection, just as God breathed into Adam's nostrils to give him life (Gen 2:7), so too Jesus breathed on his disciples to give them new life in the Holy Spirit (Jn 20:22)!

Easter is a celebration of this new beginning and the new creation that we become participants in by faith and new birth. Over the next few months, during the 10:00 a.m. worship service, we will explore the Gospel of John with help from the letters of John and Revelation. It will be a wonderful time in God's word together! Invite someone to hear about our wonderful Savior and to join us in worship of our great God and mighty living Lord!

Donations go toward the Methodist Men's projects.





Often times, young girls in other countries do not have access to personal hygiene products during their monthly cycles and aren't allowed to attend school during this time. Without education, the girls can fall subject to the physical and sexual abuse of the men in power. During our meeting, we will be making sanitary napkins that can be used, washed & cleaned, and then used again many times. We will distribute the reusable pads as part of our Samaritan's Purse Operation Christmas Child shoebox outreach in the fall.


