

From the Pastor...

There's a holiday in November, a holy day in the Church, which has been largely forgotten, even in many Christian churches. Not Thanksgiving, but All Hallows' Day. Hallows is an old English word meaning "saints" or "holy ones." Through faith in Christ all Christians are made holy by the grace of God.

During the early days of the Church, Christians set apart special services to honor and remember the saints of the Lord, who had been martyred for their faith. Over time the number of martyrs grew exponentially, and the Church decided to set apart one day a year—All Saints' Day—to honor and remember all of them together. Professor Todd Johnson of Gordon Conwell Seminary says it is



estimated that over 70 million Christians have been martyred from the beginning to the present.


We should honor and remember them because their faithful witness even unto death, serves as a reminder and example that can encourage us to remain faithful ourselves in the face of evil and the fear of death. All Saints' Day is like the Church's Memorial Day, and it is a celebration of the victory we have in Jesus over the fear of death wielded by the devil to keep people in bondage to him (Heb 2:14-15). At some point in the Middle Ages, in some places, the celebration included people dressing in costumes, including some spooky ones, to depict the victory of Christ and his saints over evil and death.

Unfortunately, All Hallows' Eve (i.e. Halloween), which marks the beginning of the celebration, has been highjacked by the world, to revel in evil and magnify fear to the effect that the true meaning of the holiday has been eclipsed. All Hallows is not a fearfest, it is a time to honor and remember all the saints in glory, especially the ones who faced evil and the real threat of death and trusted that Jesus Christ had conquered them.

In this special season of Thanksgiving, on the first Sunday of November, we will remember and honor the saints in glory and celebrate and give thanks for the victory we have in Christ over evil and fear. Join us in the celebration at Cold Springs Methodist Church on Sunday November 5th at 10:00 a.m.




Community Breakfast
