From the Pastor...

The convening conference of the Global Methodist Church was held in San Jose, Costa Rica September 20-26. From the many reports I read and heard, it was a Spirit-filled time of revival and renewal. One of the worship leaders, Mark Swayze, said a few years ago that Billy Abraham—one of the leading theologians of the Methodist renewal movement, now with the saints in glory—said that he, himself probably wouldn't see the revival within Methodism, but Billy believed Mark would. During the General Conference, Mark said Billy was right and it began in Costa Rica last month with an overwhelming experience of God's presence and holy love.

God is doing a new thing among the people called Methodists, and He wants to fill us all afresh and anew to be a greater conduit of his amazing grace in the world. But another clear message that came from the General Conference was the need for us to be desperate for God and to be emptied of self to be filled to overflowing with the grace and holy love of God. In other words, we need to be humble for "God opposes the proud, but gives grace to the humble" (James 4:6; 1 Peter 5:5-6). God desperately wants to give his grace to a humble people who are desperate for Him. Let's humbly pray that what started in Costa Rica spreads to and through all Global Methodist churches and continues and increases mightily until the Lord comes!

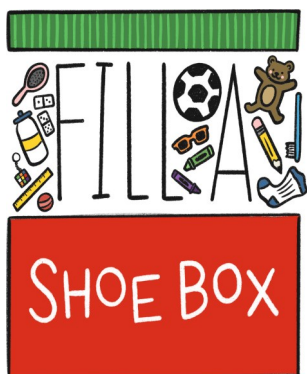
