Beginning September 10th at 5:30 p.m. we will be having weekly "Sunday Suppers and Table Talk."

This weekly gathering will be called "Getting to Know God: Sunday Supper and Table Talk." Supper will be provided each evening. After people gather and beginning eating, I will share a teaching from God's word. After the lesson (about 20-25 minutes), and over dessert there will be discussion around a few questions related to my talk.

To begin with, over the course of about 15 weeks, we will go through the Catechism of Christian Faith and Doctrine for the Global Methodist Church (booklets will be provided). Catechism is a word that refers to the process of passing down the ". faith that was once for all entrusted to God's holy people" (Jude 3). It is a way of instructing church members and prospective church members in

the essential Biblical teachings of the Christian faith so that we may know God, how to relate to God, and how best to glorify God by what we believe and how we speak and live. In Hosea 4:6, God says, "My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge . . ." Knowing God, knowing about God and knowing Him by experience in a personal relationship, is essential to living a victorious and joyous life and being a strong church.

People of all ages are invited to join us! Parents with smaller children will be grouped together so they can have discussion while the children are playing after supper. Youth are invited to join us too. Youth will meet at 4:45 each evening for fun time and at 5:30 will have supper and participate in the teaching and discussion together as well. Brenda Maxwell will be coordinating meals for each Sunday night. If your small group or Sunday School class would like to volunteer to provide a meal one evening, please let Brenda know.

I look forward to wonderful time of table fellowship as we grow together in the grace and knowledge of our Lord together!




We have something to cheer about... It's BBQ/Brunswick Stew time at Cold Springs


