From the Pastor...

“First of all, then, I urge that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for all people, for kings and all who are in high positions, that we may lead a peaceful and quiet life, godly and dignified in every way. This is good, and it is pleasing in the sight of God our Savior, who desires all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.” 1 Timothy 2:1-4 ESV

As we enter another contentious election season in the United States, as Christians we would do well not only to vote but also to pray. We should pray for all those running for office and all those who are already in office running the country, their states, and local cities, towns, and communities. The reason we should pray for all people, including government leaders, according to 1 Tim 2:1-2, is so that “we may lead, a peaceful and quite life, godly and dignified in every way.” For the apostle Paul as he was writing this letter, this would also have included the emperor, Nero, who would eventually have Paul beheaded.

We should pray for all the leaders including, and especially, for those who might be hostile to traditional Chrisitan beliefs and morality—like our belief that God designed marriage to be between one man and woman. We should pray that government leaders would at least respect the right of Christians to live according to their values and share them with others without threat of government harassment—something the early church didn’t enjoy but prayed for.

If Paul prayed for Nero, we should be able to pray for those for whom we may not be voting. And ultimately, our prayer should be according to God’s desire that all kinds of people, including politicians, be “saved and come to the knowledge of the truth.” And remember! The truth is no matter who’s in office, Jesus is Lord!

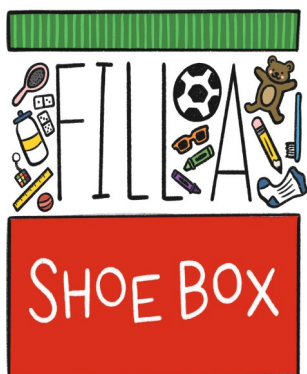
