Mark 9:23 (ESV) *And Jesus said to him, “If you can!” All things are possible for one who believes.*

Fasting Dates: Midnight, Sunday, January 11 - Sunday, January 18 (Ends After Service)

Type of Fast: Monday & Tuesday: Fruits and Vegetables, 100% juices (no sugar added)

Wednesday, Thursday, Friday: Water only (or water & 100% juices)

*** Wednesday:** Asking everyone to do either water only or liquid fast until midnight if unable to do all 3 days.

Saturday & Sunday: Fruits & Vegetables, 100% juices

*Drink plenty of water and get proper rest while fasting.

Fasting and Prayer are powerful spiritual disciplines that:

1. deepen intimacy with God which helps move distractions as we focus on Him.
2. strengthens prayer as it adds urgency to our prayers.
3. aids in spiritual growth. God’s voice and understanding is revealed to us.
4. aids in increasing self-control, clarity, deliverance, and divine guidance.
5. removes distractions as you focus on God and His word.
6. helps believers overcome temptation because it weakens the flesh.
7. helps us to align our will with God’s will and purpose for our lives.
8. helps the believer to rely on and trust God’s promises.

At Family Worship Center Church International, we are not requiring this or any fast. It is strictly voluntary. We are not asking anyone to do anything that is inconsistent with your dietary needs or against the recommendations of your medical doctor.

- Spend more time in worship, thanksgiving, and praise.
- Don't boast about your fast. Keep it a secret.
- Spend time together as a family reading the Word.
- Schedule Family Prayer every day with the declarations.
- Pray daily for the salvation of all unsaved loved ones.
- **Expect Results.** Expect a deeper and more intimate connection with God.
- **Expect** a spiritual breakthrough for your family, your church, your city.
- **Expect** God to hear and move on your behalf!
