Joshua 1:1-18

Chapter 1 divides into two sections:

- 1.Verses 1-9: God speaks to and commissions Joshua.
- 2.Verses 10-18: Joshua speaks to and prepares God's people.



Joshua 1:1-9

Two Parts:

- 1. Verses 1-5a The Charge
- 2. Verses 5b-9 The Encouragement

^{1:1} After the death of Moses the LORD's servant, the LORD spoke to Joshua son of



Verses 2-5 give a kind of table of contents for the book.



² "Moses my servant is dead. Now you and all the people prepare to cross over the Jordan to the land I am giving the Israelites."

This is the preparation to and the crossing over of the Jordan—chapter 1, through chapter 5:12.



"³ I have given you every place where the sole of your foot treads, just as I promised Moses."

This is the conquest of the land—chapter 5 verse 13, through chapter 12.

"4 Your territory will be from the wilderness and Lebanon to the great river, the Euphrates River—all the land of the Hittites—and west to the Mediterranean Sea."

This is the distribution of the land—chapters 13 through 22.



"⁵ No one will be able to stand against you as long as you live."

This is life in the land in the last days of Joshua's life—chapters 23 and 24.

I will be with you, just as I was with Moses. I will not leave you or abandon you. 6 Be strong and courageous, for you will distribute the land I swore to their ancestors to give them as an inheritance.

There's an intentional design to these verses: they're bracketed by God's presence in verse 5b and verse 9.

GOD'S PROMISES (v.6) God's promises embolden us to be strong and courageous.

If God's promises are to embolden us, we must:

1.Know God's Promises – We can't be emboldened by a promise we don't know.

3.Embrace God's Promises – We must live in their good, rest in their truth, and walk by faith in their certainty.
