

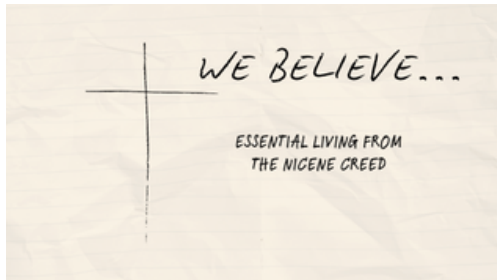

Espresso at a small cafe in Rome, a donut in Louisville, fresh squeezed orange juice in Tuscany and a hamburger in Spokane. I tasted all of these things for the first time and each left me with an unquenchable longing for more. Instant addiction. I was able to experience some of these experiences more than once (in fact I returned the very next day) while others remain a one time fond memory accompanied by an aching longing. This is what comes to

mind when I reflect on the brief stanza in the Nicene Creed that tells us about the Holy Spirit. On the one hand, the brief words capture our spiritual imagination. On the other hand, the stanza is wholly inadequate and leaves us desiring more knowledge and experiences of the presence of the Holy Spirit. We get a taste but are left with an aching longing. Today at North Point Church we will seek to explore the power and activity of the Holy Spirit in our lives. I am excited to share what the Holy Scripture teaches us about the Holy Spirit and more importantly, how you can welcome the Holy Spirit's activity and seek to discover its daily activity in your life. As we celebrate the 1700th anniversary of the writing of the Nicene Creed, the following questions can help you go deeper into the activity and experience of the Holy Spirit:

1. Where do you feel the Holy Spirit most in your life on a daily basis?
2. In looking at the Fruit of the Spirit, how can you see God at work in your life recently?
3. Have you ever found yourself working against the 'wind' of the Holy Spirit? Remember and reflect on a time when you were able to 'turn' in a way that you recognized as working with the Holy Spirit rather than against it.
