Our Advent season arrives at the final Sunday we are spending with the Prophet Isaiah. We've been asking the question of how the people who had read the Prophet's words for centuries somehow missed the coming of the Messiah. We do not ask this question to cast blame on those who missed it but rather to ask the curious questions so that we don't miss God's activity and coming into our lives. This Sunday's message will be focused on Isaiah 7:10-14 where a small sign is given with big promises. How might we learn to take note of God's fulfilling small promises in our lives so that we do not miss his coming Kingdom? The following questions may be helpful to ponder, journal on, or discuss with some trusted spiritual friends:

- 1. The people of Israel at the time of Jesus' birth were obsessed with big political, societal and religious questions that consumed their thoughts. What are the big, 'front page' stories and technologies that consume your daily time and attention?
- 2. How might you figuratively 'turn to the back pages' of spiritual truths that can help you focus on what God is up to in your life and in our world?
- 3. Where have you seen God present and active in your life this week?
