This morning we will be exploring Psalm 121 which is a Psalm of confidence and reassurance in God's good care for us. This is the second Song of Ascent, and this collection of 15 psalms has traditionally been thought to be prayed and sung by Israelites as they made their way up to Jerusalem. Unlike last week's psalm which was one of frustration and anger this is a song of reassurance– of God's unfailing love. If you think of taking a journey whether that's a physical or spiritual journey there can be many unknowns along the way. Will you get lost,

will you trip or make mistakes, will you encounter danger or maybe you're afraid to take the first step? This is a psalm meant to reassure us that "God's got your back", you don't need to fear the journey. I encourage you to reflect on Psalm 121 this week with some guided prayer.

- 1. What is your journey? Read through the psalm, notice what words stand out. What might God be calling you to? Pray for discernment.
- 2. What are your fears? As you reflect on where God is calling you, what fears do you have? Bring those fears to God in prayer.
- 3. What is your reassurance? Read through the psalm again, do the same words stand out or do different ones? What gives you confidence that you can take the first step? Thank God for His everlasting care and vigilance.
