2026 Mission Trip Info & Application

Details for the trip:

June 13-20, 2026 – Olympia, Washington: We will partner up with an organization called Praying Pelican Missions. Our plan right now is to partner with Westwood Baptist Church and stay at Northwest Christian Highschool. In the PNW there is a lot of anti-christian sentiment so our goal is to show the love of Jesus to the community through words and actions. We will focus a lot on homeless ministry, church outreach, children's ministry and some service projects around the community. Alongside PPM we will focus on helping students become world changing leaders who know and serve Jesus. This will be an amazing time of growth from the experience of serving others and the community of other committed Christians.

^{**}Students UNDER 18 at the time of the trip MUST submit a photocopy of birth certificate to Cody along with a Parent/Guardia consent form that will be provided**

Requirements for the Trip:

- Each student must attend a mandatory pre-trip Bible Study and team building. We will meet every week for the month leading up to the trip, team members must be present unless excused ahead of time. This time is usually on Sunday morning either before, after, or during services plus scheduled fundraisers or service projects.
- Each student must attend a mandatory post-trip debriefing.
- Each student must be <u>actively</u> involved in youth group between now and the trip.
- Each student must participate in scheduled activities leading up to the trip:
 - o Fundraisers Turkey Trot & SweetHeart Dinner
 - o Bible study and team building
 - One team service project
- Each student will be responsible for raising their support. The cost of the trip will be \$725 (not including deposit). Some students work, everyone will be required to send out 25 prayer/support letters, some families pay out of their budget. This is the first miracle God does on the trip! He provides.
- Applications go live October 19th November 30th. The application must be turned in with a \$200 non-refundable deposit (pending acceptance). There are a limited number of spots available. This deposit is so that Cody can book flights as soon as possible. After receiving and reviewing your application Cody will reach out with any questions if needed. By December 12th you will know whether you have been accepted on the trip.
- A parent information meeting will be held **December 14th** after 2nd service in the Youth Room to discuss trip details and fundraising.

Fundraiser Schedule:

- 1. November 28th Turkey Trot
- 2. January Prayer Letters Sent Out Each students is responsible for buying stamps & getting their letters (ready to be sent) to Cody by February 15th
- 3. February 13th Sweetheart Dinner (Each student should provide a basket no less than \$50 retail value)
- 4. Each student should work (mow lawn, shovel snow, babysit, etc.) to earn equal to or greater than \$100 to engage in Spirit-led generosity on the trip!

- Team Testimony Night January 28th after Youth Group, come ready to share with others how God saved you & is currently working in your life.
