## **Conference Rules and Instructions**

- 1. No boys in girls' rooms and no girls in boys' rooms, at any time for any reason.
- 2. RYM has a zero tolerance policy for illegal substances or materials. You may not be in possession of any weapons, drugs, alcohol, illicit or inappropriate content, etc. at any time during your week at RYM.
- 3. Do not bring full sized backpacks into large group meetings or elective classes, as there is not space in the rooms for hundreds of these. Smaller bags are okay.
- 4. Attendance at all scheduled meetings is required. Please come and listen to learn from the teachers here.
- 5. Please wear your wristband at all times. It is both your meal ticket and allows us to identity you as part of our group. There are extra wristbands available if yours breaks—just ask an RYM intern for a replacement.
- 6. Please be respectful with your personal technology—turn off your phone during elective classes and large group.
- 7. No one is allowed in the ocean at night, no exceptions. However, students are allowed on the beach at night under two conditions: 1) you must stay within RYM boundaries and 2) if a chaperone is present to supervise.
- 8. On the beach and at the pool, lifeguards and RYM Staff and Interns are in charge. Please follow their rules at all times for your safety.
- 9. Please help keep the campus clean. Dispose of your trash and respect the facility. As you depart at the end of the week, your room will be inspected for damages. Anyone who damages the property will be held responsible for the cost of such damage.
- 10. You must obey traffic signs and use the crosswalk at 15<sup>th</sup> Street when crossing Highway 98 to go to/from the beach. Do not walk out in front of moving cars!
- 11. Jogging on the beach is allowed, but not alone (bring a friend!). Always ask your chaperone for permission and notify him/her when you leave and return. In addition, <u>DO NOT</u> jog in the neighborhoods behind Laguna Beach Christian Retreat, as there is less visibility for others to see you/ you see others, if needed.
- 12. Any infraction of the conference rules can result in disciplinary action, which may include reporting legal issues to authorities, and/or being sent home at your parents' expense, etc.
