BIBLE STORY:

Moses and the Burning Bush Exodus 2-4



BIBLE STORY TIME

We had a great time learning about Moses and the burning bush! As Moses got closer to the bush, he saw that the bush did not burn up. God spoke through the bush and told Moses to go back to Egypt and tell Pharaoh to let the Israelite people leave. Moses was afraid and questioned why God would choose him to lead the Israelites, but God told Moses He would be with him and use signs to show Pharaoh. Then Moses obeyed and went back to Egypt and led the people out of Egypt to a new land! You can read the story about Moses and the burning bush to your child in a children's Bible in Exodus 2-4.

PLAY TIME



Play a game of "Simon Says" with your kid to emphasize how we show love through obedience. You can use things like; "Simon says to reach up high, touch your toes, spin in a circle, etc. When your kid obeys, ask them to say the special words with you: "We can love [Hug yourself] God by obeying Him. [Thumbs up]" Continue to repeat this game as many times as you like. At the end, ask them; "Can you obey God?" If they say, "yes", tell them that this makes God very happy! Celebrate by doing a happy dance with them.

BIBLE VERSE TIME

Be kind and forgive one another. (Draw the outline of a large smile in front of you) Just as God (point up) forgave you. (hug yourself) Ephesians 4:32 NIrV [open hands like a Bible]
