#### **BIBLE STORY TIME**

We had so much fun learning about David, the Shepherd boy. We heard how God wanted David to help his family and King Saul. David helped his family by taking care of the sheep and bringing his brothers food while they were fighting in a war. David helped King Saul by playing music for him. You can read the story about David the Shepherd Boy to your child in a children's Bible in 1 Samuel 16-18, 34-35.

## **PLAY TIME**



Play a game of pretend that has you and your kid taking turns needing help. Pretend to eat an ice cream cone and drop it. Then say "Oh no! That makes me so sad." Allow your kid to help you clean it up and share their cone with you. Once they are done say "Thank you for helping me! Let's say the special words together: **God** [point up] **wants me** [point two thumbs at yourself] **to help others** [clap hands twice]." Now, switch roles with your child and repeat the game, this time with you helping them.

#### **BIBLE VERSE TIME**
