Opening Question: What stood out to you from this weekend's message?

- Donovan explained that God's grace is enough in the inbetween. How have you experienced God's grace in the in between?
- Galatians 6:2 reminds us to, "Carry each other's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ." What does it look like to do this during times of difficulty?

Out: Your Outreach to the World
