Bible Story: David is Chosen 1 Samuel 16

Big Idea: God is King

Focus: God is King and He sees our hearts

Memory Verse: "Who is he, this King of glory? The Lord who rules over all!

He is the King of glory." Psalm 24:10 (NirV)

Bible Story Summary:

Read and meditate on 1 Samuel 16, 1 Kings 8:39, Psalm 139:1-6, Psalm 19:14, 1 Samuel 16:7

After Saul was rejected as king of Israel, God sent Samuel to Bethlehem, to the house of Jesse, to anoint one of his sons. Seven of Jesse's sons passed before Samuel, but God said no to each of them. Jesse brought in David, his youngest son. God told Samuel that David was the next king of Israel. David was not the likely choice, but man looks at appearance. God looks at the heart.

He Question: What does God know about us?

God knows everything about people, but He does not act like humans do. He is most concerned about our hearts and who we truly are on the inside.

We Question: What is God looking for in us?

God desires for His people to seek after His heart. Loving God is more important than how we look or what we can do.

Me Question: How is God inviting me to respond?

Kids will be given the opportunity to reflect on the truth they learned about God and respond accordingly.



As you finish your meal, find some paper and some scissors. If possible, have everyone draw a heart on their paper. Then have everyone cut out their heart with scissors. Have everyone write down one thing that they see in the person's heart, to the left of them, on that heart. If needed, help younger kids write on their hearts. Then have everyone share their hearts to be a reminder of what God sees in your hearts.







READ "Who is he, this King of glory? The Lord who rules over all! He is the King of glory." Psalm 24:10 (NirV)

With the help of a parent, find a piece of red or pink paper. If you can't find any red or pink paper, use a white piece of paper. Once you have a piece of paper, draw a big heart on the paper and then cut the heart out.

In the middle of the heart write the words "GOD IS KING". Have your parents help you write this, if you need help.

When you're finished, put the heart somewhere in your bedroom so you will remember that God is King.

READ Psalm 47:7-8 (NirV)

This week you learned that God really cares about what is in your heart. He wants to be the most important thing. He sees your heart and knows if you love Him.

God has given you gifts and talents. You might be a great soccer player or a great artist, but what God cares about the most is if you love Him. He cares about what is in your heart.

With the help of a parent, write one word (or draw a picture) on the heart of what God sees in your heart. Some examples might be friendly, kind, loving, helpful, or cheerful.

READ 1 Samuel 16 (NirV)

In the Bible story this week, you learned how David became the next king of Israel. God sent Samuel to Jesse's house to find the next king. At first, Jesse showed Samuel all his kids except for David. Jesse believed that David was not as great as his brothers. In the end, God chose David to be the next king because David loved God. God saw what was in David's heart. That mattered to God so He made him the next king.

READ Psalm 139:1-6 (NirV)
