Bible Story: David and the Ark 2 Samuel 5-6

Big Idea: God is King

Focus: God is King and worthy of worship.

Memory Verse: "Who is he, this King of glory? The Lord who rules over all!

He is the King of glory." Psalm 24:10 (NirV)

Bible Story Summary:

Read and meditate on 2 Samuel 5-6, 1 Timothy 1:17; Romans 12:1; Psalm 150

God gave King David great victories. He decided to bring back the ark of the covenant. He and the people had a great celebration, worshiping God along the way. David's wife, Michal, saw David dancing and worshiping, and she was angry. She ridiculed him for being an embarrassment, but David responded that he was willing to look even more foolish for God. Worshiping Him was more important than what people thought.

He Question: Why should God be worshiped?

God is our Creator, King, Savior and Promise Keeper. He deserves all of the praise and glory.

We Question: How can we worship God?

We can worship God through singing, prayer, serving and much more. Anything we do for His glory is worship.

Me Question: What does God want me to know about Him, and what does this mean for my life?

Kids will be given the opportunity to reflect on the truth they learned about God and respond accordingly.





As you are driving your child somewhere, talk about your favorite worship songs. If either of you have a favorite worship song, play that worship song. As you play the song worship God. When the song is done remind your child that singing and dancing is one way to worship God.

READ "Who is he, this King of glory? The Lord who rules over all! He is the King of glory."

This is the memory verse for this month. All month you have been learning that God is King.

Psalm 24:10 (NirV)

To practice the memory verse, sing the memory verse to the tune of Jingle Bells.

This King of glory? (Jingle bells)
The LORD who rules over all! (Jingle all the way)
He is the King (Jingle bells)
Of glory. (Jingle bells)
Psalm 24:10" (Jingle all the way)

PRACTICE this memory verse as a reminder that God is King.



READ "Brothers and sisters, God has shown you His mercy. So, I am asking you to offer up your bodies to Him while you are still alive. Your bodies are a holy sacrifice that is pleasing to God. You are worshipping Him in the right way."

Romans 1:12 (NirV)

This week you learned that God is King and worthy of worship. One way to worship God is through music. When you sing and dance, you are celebrating and thanking God for who He is.

Look around your house and find a phone, a radio, or some type of streaming device. Choose a favorite song, or turn the music, on and play an upbeat worship song. As the song plays, praise God by dancing like David did. You can also praise God by singing the song to God. Show God that you love Him, and that He is worthy to be worshipped!

READ 2 Samuel 5-6 (NirV)

2 Samuel 5-6 is our Bible story for this week. In the Bible story, we learned that David loved to worship God. Even though he danced around, he didn't care what others thought of him. He knew it was more important to worship God than care about what others think.

Read 2 Samuel 5-6 again. When you are done. answer the questions below:

Who loved to worship God by dancing?

Who got angry when David worshipped God?

What does it mean to worship God?

What is one way you can worship God?

READ Psalm 150:1-6 (NirV)

What is your favorite worship song right now? How do you feel when you listen to that song? Does it make you want to get up and dance? Or does it make you want to put your hands up in the air? Maybe it makes you want to listen quietly to the lyrics.

One way that you can worship God is through music. But that's not the only way. You worship God anytime you do something for His glory. You can worship God when you pray. You can also worship God when you do something to help others. Another way to worship God is to read your Bible. Because God is the Creator, the King, the Savior, and the Promise Keeper, He is worthy of being worshipped.

Take a moment and pray to God. Thank Him for who He is. Thank Him for creating so you can worship. Think about a way that you can worship Him this week. As you pray, let it be a moment to thank God for what He has done and for always being worthy of worship.
