Bible Story: David and the Ark 2 Samuel 5-6

Big Idea: God is King

Focus: God is King and worthy of worship.

Memory Verse: "Who is he, this King of glory? The Lord who rules over all!

He is the King of glory." Psalm 24:10 (NirV)

Bible Story Summary:

Read and meditate on 2 Samuel 5-6, 1 Timothy 1:17; Romans 12:1; Psalm 150

God gave King David great victories. He decided to bring back the ark of the covenant. He and the people had a great celebration, worshiping God along the way. David's wife, Michal, saw David dancing and worshiping, and she was angry. She ridiculed him for being an embarrassment, but David responded that he was willing to look even more foolish for God. Worshiping Him was more important than what people thought.

He Question: Why should God be worshiped?

God is our Creator, King, Savior and Promise Keeper. He deserves all of the praise and glory.

We Question: How can we worship God?

We can worship God through singing, prayer, serving and much more. Anything we do for His glory is worship.

Me Question: What does God want me to know about Him, and what does this mean for my life?

Kids will be given the opportunity to reflect on the truth they learned about God and respond accordingly.





After dinner, ask your child this question: What are some ways that you can worship God? (singing, dancing, playing instruments, serving) Share with them that anything we do for His glory is worship. Pick your favorite worship song and play it on a device. Spend a few minutes with your child praising and worshipping the Lord. He is our King and is worthy of all of our praise.
