Bible Story: Ruth Ruth 1-4

Big Idea: God deserves our thanks

Focus: God deserves our thanks even when things are hard

Memory Verse: "Give thanks to the Lord, because he is good. His faithful

love continues forever" Psalm 136:1 (NirV)

Bible Story Summary:

Read and meditate on Ruth 1-4, Psalm 16:7-8; Psalm 34:1-4; Habakkuk 3:17-19, 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18

During the Judges era, famine struck, leading Elimelech to move his family to Moab, where he and his sons died. Left with her sons' wives, Ruth and Orpah, Naomi decided to return to Judah. Orpah left, but Ruth vowed to stay with Naomi. Struggling in Bethlehem, Ruth gleaned in Boaz's field. Boaz, a relative, offered kindness. As a kinsman-redeemer, Boaz married Ruth. They had a son, Obed, bringing joy to Naomi.

Life is sometimes hard. Naomi & Ruth had some very hard times, but God was with them through it all. He provided food for them to eat and eventually added to their family. Their family line was in Jesus' genealogy. When we go through pain, God is with us through it all and still works out His good plan.

He Question: Why does God always deserve to be praised?

God is sovereign over all. He always deserves our praise for who He is. He is good, just, holy, loving, and He sits on the throne.

We Question: Does God care about my hurt?

God created us and our emotions. Jesus experienced hurt, making it possible for Him to understand us. God is not far away from our pain. He is mighty enough to understand and be with us.

Me Question: What does God want me to know about Him, and what does this mean for my life?

Kids will be given the opportunity to reflect on the truth they learned about God and respond accordingly.





When you are getting ready for bed, ask your child to list off 2 things that they are thankful for. Talk with them about how we can be thankful for so many things. He deserves all the praise on the good days and the bad days. Take a minute to pray and thank God for those blessings.





DAY 1

READ "Give thanks to the Lord, because he is good. His faithful love continues forever". Psalm 136:1 (NIrV)

A new season has begun. FALL!! Let's find a fun "fall" way to work on memorizing this month's verse. With the help of a parent, find a pumpkin. It could be a piece of paper you cut out to look like a pumpkin or maybe you picked one from the pumpkin patch. Write the verse on it with a marker and find a place to put it in your house that you will see often. Every time you pass by, read the verse to help remind you that you can always give thanks to God.

Where did you put your pumpkin?

PRACTICE this memory verse as a reminder that God always deserves our thanks.

DAY 2

READ Psalm 34:1-4 (NIrV)

On a good day, what is something you can thank God for? This verse tells us to praise the Lord at ALL times. That means when you are having a good day but more importantly that includes the hard days you face. When you are going through a tough time, what is something you can be thankful for? Our God is good, just, holy, loving, and sits on the throne. You can always find something to thank him for. With the help of a parent, draw a picture of something you can thank God for.

DAY (3)

READ Ruth 1-4 (NirV)

This week you learned about the story of Ruth and her mother in law Naomi. They both went through some hard times but God was with them through it all. He provided for them and eventually added Boaz to their family. With the help of a parent, try to match up some important words from this Bible story.
