Bible Story: Esther Esther 2-8

Big Idea: God deserves our thanks

Focus: God deserves our thanks because He is in control.

Memory Verse: "Give thanks to the Lord, because he is good. His faithful love

continues forever". Psalm 136:1 (NirV)

#### **Bible Story Summary:**

Read and meditate on Esther 2-8; Psalm 33:11; Isaiah 46:9-10; Romans 8:28; 1 Peter 2:9

Mordecai and his cousin Esther were Israelites whose family had been exiled to Persia. When the king needed a new queen, Esther was chosen. Mordecai urged her to keep her Jewish identity secret. When Haman wanted to destroy the Jews, Mordecai told Esther to help. He told her that she might be in the palace for this very reason. Though it was risky, she approached the king and revealed Haman's plan. The king was furious, punished Haman and saved the Jews.

God's plan couldn't be stopped by Haman. God was honoring the covenant He made that a Rescuer would come through Abraham's family, the Jews. He worked through Esther to save His people so the Rescuer, Jesus, could come to Earth just as He promised. Esther risked her life by admitting she was an Israelite and by approaching the king. Many years after Esther, Jesus didn't just risk His life, but gave it up to save all people. He died on the cross and rose again so that we can be rescued from death and live in God's kingdom

He Question: How can God have a plan for everything?

God is sovereign and in control. He loves us and knows what is best for the world.

We Question: Does God have a purpose for everyone?

God made each of us for a purpose. He has a great plan for our lives and works through us for His glory.

Me Question: How is God inviting me to respond?

Kids will be given the opportunity to reflect on the truth they learned about God and respond accordingly.





During dinner, talk to your child about how you had to have a plan in place to put this dinner together. If you didn't have a plan, you probably would not have eaten a healthy meal. God is in control and our plan may sound like a good plan but He has the best plan and we can trust Him. We can praise Him because He will use it for His good.





**READ** "Give thanks to the Lord, because he is good. His faithful love continues forever". Psalm 136:1 (NIrV)

Let's practice our new verse in a fun fall way. Find a piece of blank paper and red, orange. yellow, green, and brown markers.

Once you have those items, write the first word of the memory verse on the paper in the red marker. Then write the second word of the memory verse on the paper with the orange marker. 
PRACTICE this memory verse as a reminder that God deserves your thanks

Take a moment and look up a picture of the President or a King. When you look at their picture, what do you see? Do they look important or powerful? The President or a King often have power and authority because they are in charge of a country. They are supposed to help make the rules to keep their country and the people in their country safe.

Even though the President or a King are powerful, there is someone more powerful than them. There is someone who is always in control, no matter what...God!

Trace and color in the crown. Then write the word God across the crown as a reminder that God is the One who is always in control.
