Bible Story: Shadrack, Meshack, and Abednego Daniel 3

Big Idea: God deserves our thanks

Focus: God deserves our thanks because He is always with us

Memory Verse: "Give thanks to the Lord, because he is good. His faithful

love continues forever" Psalm 136:1 (NIrV)

Bible Story Summary:

Read and meditate on Daniel 3; Isaiah 41:10; Deuteronomy 31:8; Joshua 1:9

King Nebuchadnezzar made a huge golden statue and put a law into place that whoever did not bow down to the image would be thrown into a fiery furnace. Shadrack, Meshack, and Abednego chose to obey God rather than bow down to the golden statue. The king was so furious he had the furnace heat turned up 7 times hotter. Shadrack, Meshack, and Abednego were thrown into the fire, but they weren't alone. God was in the fire with them and protected them. God deserves our thanks because He is always with us.

He Question: How can God be with everyone all the time?

God is present everywhere, at all times, and in all creation. He is not limited to time or space.

We Question: What does it mean to me to know that God is with us?

We can always know that God is with us in the good and hard times, and He will help us and work all things out.

Me Question: How is God inviting me to respond?

Kids will be given the opportunity to reflect on the truth they learned about God and respond accordingly.



As a family, talk about the things that are planned for the day that they might be afraid or nervous about. Maybe it's the first day of practice for a new sport or a big test at school. Maybe it's making new friends at recess or a big project at work. Once everyone has shared something, read Joshua 1:9 (NIrV). Encourage each other to have confidence today because God is always with them.

DAY 4

READ "The Lord is my rock and my place of safety. He is the God who saves me. My God is my rock. I go to Him for safety. He is like a shield to me." Psalm 18:2 (NirV)

When you are afraid or unsure, remember God is always there! This verse says that God is like our rock, a sturdy place beneath our feet to stand on when things get shaky.

Go outside and look for a rock that is big enough to write on, but that you can still hold in your hand. When you find one, write out part of this week's Focus, "God is always with me". Keep the rock somewhere you will see it often as a reminder that God is always with you.

Then take a moment to pray and thank God for always being with you.

"Dear God. This week I learned that you are always with me just like you were with Shadrack, Meshack, and Abednego. Whenever I am scared or in a tough situation, help me to remember that you are always with me. Thank You for being with me. I love You. In Your name I pray, Amen."
