Bible Story: John the Baptist *Matthew 3:1–12; Luke 3:1–18*

Big Idea: Jesus is God's Son

Focus: Jesus is God's Son and He is greater than anyone

Memory Verse: "But these are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God." *John 20:31a NIRV*

Bible Story Summary:

Read and meditate on *Matthew 3:1–12; Luke 3:1–18, Philippians 2:9; Colossians 1:19–20; Matthew 6:33; John 3:30*

Before Jesus was born, an angel told Zechariah that his wife Elizabeth would have a son named John. John would prepare the people for the coming Messiah and fulfill the prophecy of Isaiah. John grew up in the wilderness, preached repentance and baptized people in the Jordan River. He rebuked religious leaders for relying on tradition instead of true repentance. When people wondered if he was the Messiah, John said the true Messiah was coming, one mightier than him, who would baptize with the Holy Spirit. The Messiah's name is Jesus. **Jesus is God's Son and greater than any person who has ever lived.**

He Question: Who is Jesus?

Jesus is God's Son, the promised Messiah. Because Jesus is God, He is greater than any person who has ever lived or will ever live.

We Question: How can we put Jesus first?

We can be humble and recognize His way and His plan matter the most.

Me Question: How is God inviting me to respond?

Kids will be given the opportunity to reflect on the truth they learned about God and respond accordingly.



Talk to your child about how they can point people to Jesus. It doesn't have to be anything big. It could be a nice gesture of baking cookies to give to your neighbor or writing a kind message to a friend. Maybe it's sharing with someone how God provided during a hard time. Anything we do or say points people to Jesus. Jesus is greater than anyone and we should want to point everyone we are around to Him.

PRACTICE this memory verse as a reminder that Jesus is God's son.

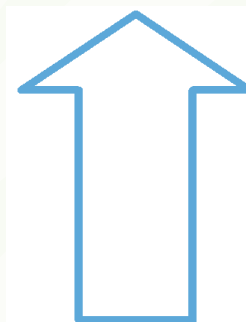
DAY 2

READ *Matthew 3:33 & John 3:30 (NIRV)*

These verses share how God should be first in all you do. Are you a great basketball player? Should you take all the credit? Are you an amazing artist? Should you take all the credit? Are you really good at dance? Should you take all the credit? No. God gave you all of those skills and talents and you should make sure to thank Him. In all you do, you should want to point people to Jesus.

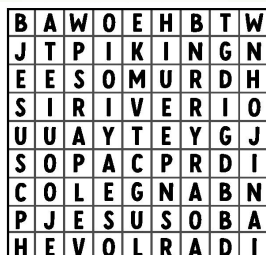
DAY 3
