Bible Story: Abraham's Call *Genesis 12:1-9; 15:1-6; 17:1-8*

Big Idea: I can trust God no matter what

Focus: I can trust God's plan

Memory Verse: "God's way is perfect. The Lord's word doesn't have any flaws." *Psalm 18:30a (NirV)*

Bible Story Summary:

Read and meditate on **Genesis 12:1-9, 15:1-6, 17:1-8, 2 Peter 1:3-4, Romans 8:28, Philippians 4:19**

God called Abraham to leave His home and go to a new land. God promised to bless Abraham, to give him many descendants, and to give them a great land. God promised the whole earth would be blessed by this family. Abraham obeyed and journeyed toward the land God had given him. God affirmed His covenant with Abraham and said he would have as many descendants as the number of stars in the sky. Abraham believed God's promise

He Question: Why does God make promises?

God made promises because He has a plan for the world. His promises teach us about His character, faithfulness, and love.

We Question: Does God make promises to us now?

God loves us so much that He planned from the beginning to provide a Savior so we could be with Him forever.

Me Question: What does God want me to know about Him, and what does this mean for my life?

Kids will be given the opportunity to reflect on the truth they learned about God and respond accordingly.



As you eat breakfast, ask your kids about their plans for the day and what they want to do.

Discuss if there is anything they are worried or excited about. Pray with your kid(s) asking God to help them remember that He has a plan they can trust, so they do not have to worry about what will happen.

DAY 1

READ "God's way is perfect. The Lord's word doesn't have any flaws." *Psalm 18:30a (NirV)*

READ "My God will meet all your needs. He will meet them in keeping with his wonderful riches. These riches come to you because you belong to Christ Jesus." *Philippians 4:19 (NirV)*

In our Bible story for this week, we learned how God made a promise to Abraham. He had a plan for Abraham that was hard for him to believe. He promised Abraham that He would be used to make a great nation.

Just like God had a plan for Abraham, He has a plan for you too. He made promises to Abraham, and He makes promises to you!

On each star, write one attribute of God. A few examples of attributes of God are loving, kind, merciful, faithful, and holy. Let these stars be a reminder that God always keeps His promises, and you can trust His plan for you.
