Bible Story: The Twelve Spies Numbers 13-14

Big Idea: I can always trust God

Focus: I can always trust God's plan

Memory Verse: "Lord, those who know you will trust in you." *Psalm 9:10a (NIrV)*

Bible Story Summary:

Read and meditate on Numbers 13-14. Jeremiah 17:7-8: John 14:1: Psalm 20:7

The Israelites finally reached the land God had promised them. Moses sent twelve spies to check it out. After exploring, the spies reported that the land was great, just like God said. However, ten of the spies feared the people in the land. Joshua and Caleb argued that the land was good and that the Israelites should trust God's plan to take over the land. The people trusted the ten spies and became angry with Joshua and Caleb. Since the people didn't trust God, Joshua and Caleb were the only ones God allowed into the Promised Land. The Israelites wandered in the wilderness for forty years.

He Question: Why can God be trusted?

God is faithful and completely trustworthy. We may not always understand God's ways, but because He is completely good, everything He does is right and good.

We Question: What does it mean to trust God?

We believe God loves us and knows what's best. We depend on Him and trust we can seek to live life His way because we know He is in control.

Me Question: How is God inviting me to respond?

Kids will be given the opportunity to reflect on the truth they learned about God and respond accordingly.



When you sit down to eat, ask your child what they want to be when they grow up. Share with them that we may have a certain plan for our life, but it may not turn out exactly how we want it to. When we trust in God's plan, it will always be for our good. His plans never fail.







READ "Some trust in chariots. Some trust in horses. But we trust in the Lord our God." Psalm 20:7 (NirV)

Find someone you trust like a parent or sibling. Then find something like a piece of fabric or a shirt that you can use as a blindfold. Have the other person help tie the item around your face so you can't see. Then have that person lead you around part of your house to get to a different room. Once you get to a new room, take off the blindfold and switch roles. Lead your sibling or parent around the house without them being able to see anything.

Why did you trust your parent or sibling to walk you through your house? You probably trusted them because you know they always love you, and they will lead you the right way. God is the same. He loves you so much! Because He loves you so much, He can be trusted. He has a plan for you, and His plans are the best. You may not be able to see the plans that God has for you. But you can always trust God the same way you trusted your parent or sibling.

KNOW that you can always trust God



READ Jeremiah 17:7-8 (NIrV)

Every tree has roots. They usually go down into the ground so deep and so wide to make sure they can get the water they need to survive. The tree depends on the roots just like we need to depend on God. If we trust in Him and the plans that He has for us, He will bless us. We will always have everything we need.

READ Numbers 13-14 (NIrV)

The Israelites thought they had a better plan than God. They did not trust in God's plan. God forgave them for disobeying but they missed out on being able to go into the Promised Land. When we think our plan is better than God's plan we are not trusting in Him and we will miss out on the great things He has for us. Our plan will fail. His plans never fail and we can always trust His plan to be the best plan.
