Bible Story: Creation Genesis 1

Big Idea: I can trust God no matter what

Focus: I can trust God because He created everything.

Memory Verse: "God's way is perfect. The Lord's word doesn't have any

flaws. Psalm 18:30a (NIrV)

Bible Story Summary:

Read and meditate on Genesis 1, Colossians 1:16, Psalm 19:1;139:14

In the very beginning, only God existed. The world was empty and formless. God showed His power when He created everything just by speaking. He made light and dark, water and sky, land, seas, and plants, the sun and the moon, fish, birds and land animals. Finally, God made people. People were His most precious creation. He made them in His image. God looked at all of creation and called it good. He rested on the seventh day. God is the Creator. He made the whole world and everything in it, and He rules over it today.

He Question: Why did God create the world?

God created the world to show His glory, and so people could know and love Him.

We Question: How are people special in God's creation?

God made man and woman in His image. He created each of us to have a special relationship with Him.

Me Question: What does God want me to know about Him, and what does this mean for my life?

Kids will be given the opportunity to reflect on the truth they learned about God and respond accordingly.





When you sit down to eat, talk to your child about God's creation. He has created so many beautiful and special things that we get to see and enjoy. (flowers, sunsets, mountains, animals, oceans...) Have your child share one thing that they love that God has created. He created the world to show His glory, and we can trust Him with everything.







READ "God's way is perfect. The Lord's Word doesn't have any flaws." Psalm 18:30a (NIrV)

It's a new month! Let's practice our new verse outside with some chalk. Create several hopscotch boxes with your chalk. In each box, write one word of our verse. In the last box write Psalms 18:30a. Try to hop from box to box and as you do, practice saying each word in the verse. If you don't have any chalk you could write each word of the verse on pieces of paper and hop from paper to paper to help vou practice

How many times did you practice your verse?

PRACTICE this memory verse as a reminder that I can trust God no matter what.

READ Colossians 1:16-17 (NIrV)

All things were created by God! Look around outside. God created all the animals, flowers, stars, planets, and people. This verse shares how everything was created by Him and for Him. He created all of those things for a reason. He even created you and has a special purpose for you. Our God holds it all together, and we can trust Him because He created everything.

READ Genesis 1 (NIrV)

READ Psalm 19:1; Psalm 139:14 (NIrV)
