TODAY: DECEMBER 20-21

Bible Story: Jesus is Born - *Luke 2:1-21*

Big Idea: Jesus is with us

Memory Verse: "Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you. He is the Messiah, the Lord." *Luke 2:11 (NIV)*

Focus: Jesus is with us and came to save us

Bible Story Summary:

Read and meditate on John 3:16, Mark 1:15; Mark 16:15, Philippians 2:6-8

The promised Savior is here! Mary and Joseph traveled to Bethlehem, and Mary gave birth to a baby boy. A large group of angels appeared to shepherds and announced that Jesus had been born. They said that this was good news of great joy. Jesus was the Savior. After the angels went away, the shepherds rushed to see the baby. They praised God for all He had done and shared what they had seen and heard. Mary treasured all of these things in her heart.

He Question: Why did Jesus come as a baby?

Jesus could have come to Earth as a king or a warrior, but He humbled Himself to come as a tiny baby. He lived a full human life, experiencing all the same things we do. Jesus came to rescue us.

We Question: How can a baby save us from our sins?

Jesus grew up and lived a perfect life. He died on the cross to take the punishment for our sin. He rose again, defeating death and making a way for us to live with God forever.

Me Question: How is God inviting me to respond?

Kids will be given the opportunity to reflect on the truth they learned about God and respond accordingly.



While you are driving, ask your child if they remember being a baby. Share some of your favorite memories of them when they were small. God sent His Son to this earth as a baby. He went through life just like we are, learning and growing. He experienced all the same things we do. He knew He would come to this earth to die for us on the cross so we could live with Him forever! Christmas is a time for us to remember that He is with us and He came to save us

DAY 1

READ "Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you. He is the Messiah, the Lord." *Luke 2:11 (NIV)*

DAY 2

READ "God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son. Anyone who believes in Him will not die but will have eternal life." *John 3:16 (NIV)*

Is it nice to get a few new toys? Is it nice to get a new pair of shoes? Is it nice to get a new video game? Yes, but that's not what Christmas is all about. The true meaning of Christmas is about God sending His Son to this world to grow up on the earth. He taught you how you should live and when the time came, died on the cross for your sins. He did that so you could live with Him forever. With the help of a parent, draw a cross to help you remember that He came for you.

READ Luke 2:1-21 (NIRV)
