Bible Story: Wisdom with Words Proverbs 18:21,10:19,15:1,12:18

Big Idea: God is wise.

Focus: God is wise and gives us wisdom in how we speak.

Memory Verse: The Lord gives wisdom. Knowledge and understanding

comes from His mouth." (Proverbs 2:6 NIrV)

### **Bible Story Summary:**

Read and meditate on Proverbs 18:21, 10:19, 15:1, 12:18, James 1:19, Ephesians 4:29, Psalm 19:14, Proverbs 21:23.

Our words are powerful. They can hurt or harm, bringing life or death to others. God wants us to be wise in how we speak to others. We honor God with kind, gentle, honest and careful words that bring life to those around us. When we speak harshly, argue or gossip we hurt others and ourselves. Proverbs reminds us that often it is better for us to not speak. Our words show what is in our hearts. They should honor God.

He Question: Does God care how I speak to others?

God wants me to honor Him and others with my words. Our words can be used to bring Him glory rather than hurt others.

We Question: Why do our words matter?

Our words are powerful. Our words can hurt others and ruin our own lives. God calls us to be wise in how we speak.

Me Question: What does God want me to know about Him, and what does this mean for my life?

Kids will be given the opportunity to reflect on the truth they learned about God and respond accordingly.



When you sit down for a meal, talk to your kid about why our words matter. Ask them what are some kind and unkind words. Have everyone take a turn saying something kind about the person on their left.





READ "The Lord gives wisdom. Knowledge and understanding comes from His mouth." Proverbs 2:6 (NIrV)

You have been working to memorize Proverbs 2:6 this month. Memorizing something is always more fun when you add silly voices. Pick a voice from the list and practice saying your verse using that voice. Practice the verse a few times using different voices and then with the help of a parent write on the line which voice was your favorite.

Slow like a sloth


Which of the voices was your favorite way to say the memory verse?

READ Proverbs 18:21 & Proverbs 10:19

READ "Ephesians 4:29 & Proverbs 21:23

It is easier to not say something than to say something and try and take it back.

### READ Proverbs 15:1 & Proverbs 12:18

Remember our lesson from Sunday about the toothpaste? It was so easy to squeeze the toothpaste out but so hard to get it back in the tube. Our words matter. They can hurt others so quickly if we are not wise with the words that come from our mouths. We have to be wise in how we speak to others. The next time you brush your teeth, let that tube of toothpaste be a reminder that we have to be wise with our words.

With the help of a parent, take a moment and pray to God. Thank Him for giving you the Bible. Thank Him that you have a book full of wisdom that you can look to. Ask Him to help you show honor to Him with the words that come out of your mouth.

"Dear God, Thank You for giving us directions on how to be wise with our words. Help us to honor You this week in what we say. Help us to have words that are kind and encouraging to others. In your name I pray, Amen."
