## PARENT CORNER

TODAY: JULY 27 weekly

Bible Story: Wisdom in How We Use Money Proverbs 3:9–10, 30:7–9

Big Idea: God is wise.

Focus: God is wise and gives us wisdom in how we use our money.

Memory Verse: The Lord gives wisdom. Knowledge and understanding

comes from His (Proverbs 2:6 NIrV)

#### **Bible Story Summary:**

Read and meditate on Proverbs 3:9-10, 30:7-9, Proverbs 19:17, Malachi 3:10, 1 Timothy 6:10, 1 Timothy 6:17-19

Solomon was the wisest man on Earth, and also the richest. Many proverbs are about how we deal with money. God wants us to be generous toward Him and others. Whether we are rich or poor, God loves us. We should handle money responsibly since we are managing God's resources, and we should never let money become too important in our lives. Money is temporary. When we die it will not matter how rich we were. The only thing that will matter is if we know Jesus as our Savior. God gives us wisdom in how we can use money to honor Him.

He Question: Does God care about money?

Everything belongs to God. He gives us money and resources to manage, and He wants us to use them wisely.

We Question: How does God want us to view money?

Everything we have is a gift from God. God wants us to be generous toward Him and others. He wants us to be responsible and honest, not letting money be too important to us.

Me Question: What does God want me to know about Him, and what does this mean for my life?

Kids will be given the opportunity to reflect on the truth they learned about God and respond accordingly.



Before leaving for school, find your container where you keep your money. Pull out a little bit of money from your container. It could be a few coins or a few dollars. Think about how you can be wise with your money, and use that money, to help someone else this week





**READ** "The Lord gives wisdom. Knowledge and understanding comes from His mouth." Proverbs 2:6 (NIrV)

Proverbs 2:6 is our memory verse for the month. This verse is a reminder that God is wise and gives us wisdom. Throughout the Bible, God uses verses like this to share His wisdom with you.

To practice the memory verse for this week, find a coin somewhere around your house. Once you find a coin, place the coin on a hard surface like a table or a counter. When you're ready, spin the coin. As the coin spins, say the memory verse. See if you can say the memory verse before the coin stops spinning. Continue to spin the coin, and say the memory verse, until you say it before the coin stops spinning

How many times did you spin the coin to say the full memory verse?

PRACTICE this memory verse as a reminder that God is wise.

# DAY 2

#### READ Proverbs 3:9-10 (NIrV)

Look at the pictures below. There is a picture of money and a picture of a heart.

Start by drawing a person standing next to the money. This person is focused on money. It's easy for us to be just like this person. When we are focused more on money, we buy the things we want and are not wise with our money.

Now draw a person standing next to the heart. This person is focused on the heart. God wants us to be just like this person. When we follow our heart, we are more willing to spend our money to help others. Focusing on our heart, and the hearts of others, allows us to be wise with our money.





# DAY 3

#### **READ** Luke 12:16-21 (NIrV)

Our Bible story this week teaches us that God wants us to be wise with our money. The rich man was not wise with his money. He had a lot of money, but he stored it in his barns instead of giving some of his money to others. He was more focused on having as much money as he could instead of focusing on being wise with his money.

Take a moment to reread the Bible story. Then answer the following true or false questions.

TRUE or FALSE: The rich man gave his money to others who needed money.

TRUE or FALSE: God was proud of the rich man for saving all his money.

TRUE or FALSE: God wants us to use our money wisely.

#### **READ** 1 Timothy 6:17-19 (NIrV)
