Bible Story: Wisdom in How We Use Money Proverbs 3:9–10, 30:7–9

Big Idea: God is wise.

Focus: God is wise and gives us wisdom in how we use our money.

Memory Verse: The Lord gives wisdom. Knowledge and understanding

comes from His (Proverbs 2:6 NIrV)

Bible Story Summary:

Read and meditate on Proverbs 3:9-10, 30:7-9, Proverbs 19:17, Malachi 3:10, 1 Timothy 6:10, 1 Timothy 6:17-19

Solomon was the wisest man on Earth, and also the richest. Many proverbs are about how we deal with money. God wants us to be generous toward Him and others. Whether we are rich or poor, God loves us. We should handle money responsibly since we are managing God's resources, and we should never let money become too important in our lives. Money is temporary. When we die it will not matter how rich we were. The only thing that will matter is if we know Jesus as our Savior. God gives us wisdom in how we can use money to honor Him.

He Question: Does God care about money?

Everything belongs to God. He gives us money and resources to manage, and He wants us to use them wisely.

We Question: How does God want us to view money?

Everything we have is a gift from God. God wants us to be generous toward Him and others. He wants us to be responsible and honest, not letting money be too important to us.

Me Question: What does God want me to know about Him, and what does this mean for my life?

Kids will be given the opportunity to reflect on the truth they learned about God and respond accordingly.



When you are getting ready for bed, talk to your child about ways you could use your money wisely. Maybe it's going to the store and buying supplies to make cookies for someone who is having a hard time or giving money to a homeless person around town. God wants us to be wise with how we use the money that He has given us.

God wants us to be wise with our money. What we do with our money, and using it wisely, brings honor to Him.


With the help of a parent, draw a picture of how you would use your envelope of money.
