Bible Story: Jonah Jonah 1-4

Big Idea: God deserves our thanks

Focus: God deserves our thanks because He forgives us

Memory Verse: "Give thanks to the LORD, because he is good. His faithful

love continues forever" Psalm 136:1 (NIrV)

Bible Story Summary:

Read and meditate on Jonah 1-4, Psalm 32:1, Ephesians 1:7, 1 John 1:9, Psalm 103:12. Isaiah 43:25

God told Jonah to go to Nineveh and tell them to repent of their sins. Jonah did not obey God, and he got on a boat that was heading the opposite way, to Tarshish. God sent a wild storm, and the ship was in danger. Jonah knew it was because of his sin, so he told them to throw him overboard. When they did, the storm stopped.

God sent a large fish to swallow Jonah, where he stayed for 3 days. Jonah cried to God for forgiveness, so God had the fish spit Jonah onto dry land. God forgave Jonah and sent Jonah to Nineveh to preach repentance. The people did repent, and God forgave them, too.

He Question: Does God forgive everyone?

Bad things happen because our world is broken by sin. Some things look like they will never be better, but God is greater. He uses everything for His perfect plan to redeem His people and to bring glory to Himself.

We Question: How can I be forgiven of my sin?

The Bible says that all who believe in the Lord Jesus Christ will be forgiven and saved. Belief in Jesus is believing that He died for sins, rose again to life, and following Him.

Me Question: How is God inviting me to respond?

Kids will be given the opportunity to reflect on the truth they learned about God and respond accordingly.



Before going to bed, talk to your child about mistakes they have made. Maybe you can share a mistake that you have made this week. Talk with them about how we sin and recognizing our sins and asking for forgiveness is so important. God loves us so much that he sent his son to die on the cross for our mistakes.







READ "Give thanks to the Lord, because He is good. His faithful love continues forever". Psalm 136:1 (NIrV)

It is the last week to work on memorizing this verse. Christmas is just around the corner!! To get into the Christmas spirit, let's put this verse to a popular Christmas tune. Pick a Christmas song to sing the words of this verse to. It may take a few tries to find the right melody.

READ Ephesians 1:7, 1 John 1:9, Psalm 103:12 (NIrV)

What do these verses have in common?

Sin is anything wrong that you do. Stealing something from the store, disobeying your parents, hitting your brother or sister are all examples of sin. If you recognize the wrong things you do and ask God to forgive you of those, He will! He loves you so much that He would forgive you of those mistakes.

Write out a sin that you have done. Then with a black marker or crayon scribble over it. Let this be a reminder that he removes those sins and forgives you.

READ Jonah 1-4 (NIrV)

This week in large group, you heard the story of Jonah. He did not want to obey God when he was asked to go to Nineveh. Jonah jumped on a boat headed for the opposite direction, gets stuck in a storm, and ends up in the belly of a big fish. Jonah realizes he disobeyed God and asks for forgiveness. Does God forgive him? YES! And God will forgive you of your mistakes if you ask Him.
