5. Respond with \_\_\_\_\_. – *Ruth 3:10–14*



## Monday

**READ:** Ruth 1

**REFLECT:** Ruth commits herself to be consistently present with Naomi. In our church community, we can strive to give each other the gift of consistent presence by carrying their burdens and serving them regardless of any inconvenience it may cost us.

**RESPOND:** How can you give the gift of consistent presence to others in your life? Ask God to give you insight and wisdom in how you may do so.

## Tuesday

**READ:** Ruth 2

**REFLECT:** Ruth took refuge in the protection and provision of Boaz. In response, Boaz demonstrated his love for Ruth by committing to provide for her. We reflect Jesus to each other when we remember how he takes care of us when we take refuge in him. And then we can seek to be a place of refuge for others.

**RESPOND:** Who can you be a refuge for by protecting and providing for them? Write down several names God gives you and seek out ways to be a refuge for them.

## Wednesday

**READ:** Ruth 3

**REFLECT:** Boaz was Ruth's “guardian-redeemer,” an “avenger” who restored families by reclaiming land, freeing relatives, and providing heirs. A “guardian-redeemer” had to be both able and willing, but the one in need had to ask. Likewise, we must humbly seek out help and support. Jesus is our true redeemer; he saves those who ask!

**RESPOND:** Is it hard for you to ask for help? If asking for help is difficult, ask God to show you why, for courage to ask for help, and the wisdom needed to take any next steps.

## Thursday

**READ:** Ruth 4

**REFLECT:** Naomi was blessed by God in ways she did not expect. As a result, her peers and friends celebrated the good work God did in her life. Church community means celebrating with each other in every season. As God blesses us, he wants us to be a blessing to others and to celebrate what he does in their lives.

**RESPOND:** Who can you celebrate with? How can you celebrate with them over God's blessings in their lives?

## Friday

**READ:** 1 Thessalonians 5:14

**REFLECT:** Paul wrote to the Thessalonian believers telling them they have a responsibility to attend to the spiritual health and well-being of their church community. The church community's purpose is to build each other up. We are best when we focus on others and serve them with sacrificial love.

**RESPOND:** Spend time praying for the spiritual health and well-being of Pathway. Ask God how you can positively contribute to the church's well-being.
