Monday

READ: Hebrews 12:1-3

REFLECT: Although we are trying to live the Christian life, it's easy to get distracted. With other people running alongside, things not going your way, and things stealing your attention, it's tough to stay focused on Jesus. But the whole idea is to stick to your own lane and keep your eyes on Jesus. The Spirit will empower you to endure!

RESPOND: What are the hindrances that are entangling you? How can you throw them off so you can run your race with endurance?

Tuesday

READ: Ephesians 2:10

REFLECT: Every believer is made by God to run a race marked by good works. These good works are not the basis for salvation but the result of it. God has uniquely equipped each one of us with what we need to run the race with perseverance. Our role is to start running the race and trust him to give us what we need when we need it.

RESPOND: How has your new life in Christ been marked by good works? How can you use your story to serve others with good works?

Wednesday

READ: Psalm 8:4-8

REFLECT: We can sometimes feel small while living amid the giant universe. With so many people and so many concerns and needs, why would God focus on us? David asked this question in this psalm. The truth is that God thinks much of you. In fact, he has given you gifts and a story to make a difference in the lives of others and in the world.

RESPOND: Spend time praising God for his love for you. What are some ways you can make a difference in the lives of others this week?

Thursday

READ: Romans 15:13

REFLECT: For us to give hope to others, we must be filled with hope. God has promised to give us this hope and to fill us with joy and peace as we trust in him. The Holy Spirit empowers us to overflow with abundant hope that is contagious to those we engage with.

RESPOND: Are you feeling hopeful today? If not, ask God to fill you with his hope, joy, and peace. How can you offer this hope to others through your words and your life?

Friday

READ: Romans 8:24-25

REFLECT: Our hope in God is something we experience in part now and will know in full when he returns. Until then, we are to run our race with hope and keep our eyes focused on Jesus. As we do, we will be able to give hope to others and run with endurance.

RESPOND: Praise God for the hope he promises in his return. How can you give this hope to others this week?
