Monday

READ: Genesis 2:18

REFLECT: God's declaration that "It is not good for man to be alone" stresses the importance of others in our lives. The presence and companionship of others is a constant theme in the Bible. God has placed this desire for others' presence in our lives, and we are simply matching His desire when we yearn for companionship.

RESPOND: Thank God for others He has placed in your life. If you find yourself lacking in good relationships, ask God to reveal to you why that may be.

Tuesday

READ: 1 Samuel 18:1-9

REFLECT: David may seem like someone who is alone or above others when he does great things for God. However, immediately after defeating Goliath, David found friendship with Jonathan. This was God's doing. As soon as God worked in David's life, He knew David needed the close support of someone else.

RESPOND: What are the opportunities God has given you for friendships with others? Are you acting upon these opportunities by developing friendships?

Wednesday

READ: Ecclesiastes 4:7-12

REFLECT: Life is richer, safer, warmer, and more meaningful when we share it with others. The pursuit of wealth and success is meaningless without relationships. Many people pursue careers and wealth only to discover there is no one with whom to share their successes. Friends without money is better than money without friends.

RESPOND: Do your priorities align with the stated realities in Ecclesiastes 4:7-12? If not, what steps can you take to align your pursuits with these realities?

Thursday

READ: Acts 2:42; Romans 12:10

REFLECT: As believers, we are called into community with each other. God doesn't look at community as a "bonus" in life. He commands it because having relationships with other believers is essential. When we devote ourselves to community, we're obeying God's command and fulfilling our hearts' need.

RESPOND: How are you devoted to the friends in your life? How can you intentionally serve them over the next few days?

Friday

READ: Galatians 6:2; Matthew 22:36-40

REFLECT: Paul urges believers to carry each other's burdens — struggles, temptations, emotional pain, financial struggles, illness — hardships that are too heavy to bear alone. By doing so, we fulfill Christ's law to love our neighbor as ourselves.

RESPOND: Think of others who have borne your burdens. Seek to do for others what has been done for you by others.
