# <u>Up</u>

- -Read John 4:1-30. What stands out, confuses, or challenges you from this passage or the message?
- -What do we learn about our Father from how He responds throughout this conversation with the Samaritan woman?
- -In what ways did the Samaritan woman try to deflect the conversation away from herself? How do we fall into doing the same thing with God?

### In

- -We all have times where we try to fulfill deeper truths with temporary distractions/relief. What has been your pattern with this?
- -The woman eventually uses her story to tell others about Christ. How has God used your story to tell others about Himself?

## **Out**

- -How does having a firm understanding of our own patterns of missing the deeper truths help us develop compassion for those others around us? Who comes to mind?
- -Pastor Ron points out that Jesus goes to where the Samaritan woman was, rather than waiting for her to come to Him. Where do you bring Christ into places of hurt and brokenness?

## **Prayer**

-Spend time praying as a group for us to develop a deeper thirst for Jesus, not merely knowledge-but an awareness and relationship with Him.
