Monday

READ: John 4:1-6

REFLECT: While there could have been a physical barrier blocking him from going any other way, Jesus ultimately had a mission to go through Samaria and rest at a well. He was sensitive to his Father's direction to simply wait and see, even though he was tired. Sometimes, to be used by God, we just have to be available.

RESPOND: How can you position yourself to wait and see what God will do around you? How can you slow down and be available for God to use you to help the hurting?

Tuesday

READ: John 4:7-9

REFLECT: Jesus openly spoke to a Samaritan woman despite it being socially taboo. He did not allow a social taboo to stop him from being present for her. He was more concerned with being present for a hurting woman than with what others thought of him. He was others-centered.

RESPOND: What would your day look like if you decided to focus on being present for others? What changes can you make so you can be more present for the hurting?

Wednesday

READ: John 4:10-15

REFLECT: Jesus met the woman's physical and emotional needs but also invited her into a relationship with him. While she was focused on the social taboo of their interaction, Jesus turned her attention to eternal life. He showed compassion for her pain and brokenness but did so in a way that offered her lasting healing and hope.

RESPOND: How can you meet the physical and emotional needs of the hurting while also helping meet their spiritual need for a personal relationship with Jesus?

Thursday

READ: John 4:16-24

REFLECT: As the Samaritan woman tried to deflect from Jesus' knowledge of her personal life, he directed her toward her need for God. He simply acknowledged her history but did not condemn it, which created an opportunity for conversation and trust.

RESPOND: How can you build trust with those who are hurting? Think of someone who may be hurting and write down some ways you can authentically build trust.

Friday

READ: John 4:25-26

REFLECT: It was only after discussing the woman's questions that Jesus identified himself as the Messiah. She was the first person to whom Jesus openly revealed his identity, and it only occurred after respectful conversation. This demonstrates compassionate patience rather than rapid-fire debate fueled by condemnation.

RESPOND: Ask God to help you be more patient with those who are hurting. Ask him for wisdom to know how to talk with them and to lead them to truth in his timing.
