Monday

READ: Mark 5:21–43

REFLECT: Jesus' tender compassion is on display as he goes to Jairus's house to heal his daughter. Just as Jesus met Jairus in his grief, he will also meet you in your grief. While he may not heal you or those you long to see healed, he promises to be present.

RESPOND: In what ways has Jesus been near to you during a season of grief? How can you be near to others during their seasons of grief?

Tuesday

READ: Psalm 147:3

REFLECT: God is like a doctor who restores the broken parts of your body. The picture in this verse is one of a loving, gentle hand that heals, restores, and creates something new from brokenness and pain. God sees your grief and brings comfort. Trusting him and seeking out his healing are key to experiencing his comfort.

RESPOND: What are several ways you can demonstrate trust in God and seek out his comfort and healing?

Wednesday

READ: Deuteronomy 31:8; Ecclesiastes 3:11

REFLECT: Grief often makes us feel like we are out of control. In response, we try to do life our way. But God invites us into the reality where he is in control of all things. When we choose to trust him, we discover that God knows what he is doing and is trustworthy.

RESPOND: What are some practical steps you can take to lean into God's control of all things? How can you let go of what is uncontrollable during your seasons of grief?

Thursday

READ: Isaiah 61:3

REFLECT: We often get caught up in asking God "why?" during grief. However, we may need to ask more "what" questions. For example, "What are you doing in and through my grief? What do you want me to learn?" God will turn your grief into something for your good and his glory if you allow him.

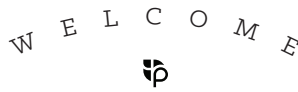
RESPOND: Spend time asking God "what" he wants you to learn in your grief. Write down several ways you've grown from your seasons of grief.

Friday

READ: Isaiah 40:31; Romans 8:28

REFLECT: Grief can be spiritually, emotionally, and physically exhausting. Yet God promises that he will take us to a season of renewal and refreshment. God has worked, is working, and will continue to work out all things, including your grief, for your good and his glory. Even amid our pain, God is still good.

RESPOND: Pray something like this: God, thank you for showing me your faithfulness in the past. Help me to trust you and cling to your goodness now and in the days to come.

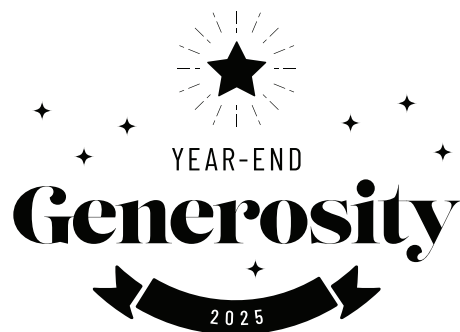
