Monday

READ: Ruth 1

REFLECT: Ruth's insistence on going where Naomi went revealed her love for Naomi and her awareness that Ruth was not the center of the story. Whether she realized it or not, Ruth lived out the reality that God's purpose for us is often greater than ourselves. We do not live for ourselves. We live for God and others.

RESPOND: Think of a time in your life that was difficult but resulted in helping others. How does this change your perspective? How can it help you in challenging situations?

Tuesday

READ: Ruth 2:2-4; Romans 8:28

REFLECT: When Naomi sent Ruth to glean in the fields, verse 3 says, "as it turned out" (NIV) or "she happened to come" (ESV). This was not a coincidence. God was at work behind the scenes. He is the master, coordinating your life according to his will. He always initiates the right plan for the right circumstances to achieve the right outcome.

RESPOND: Do you trust God to work out all things for your good and his glory? How does your life demonstrate this? Ask God to increase your faith in his hand and wisdom.

Wednesday

READ: Ruth 4

REFLECT: God remembered his covenant with Israel and Naomi's bitterness. As a result, he rewarded them with blessing. He acted on his promises. Not one of God's promises has ever failed or ever will fail. As you obey him, you can trust that he will never forget you and he will reward your faithfulness.

RESPOND: Thank God for always remembering and rewarding. Ask him to help you obey him so you can know and love him more.

Thursday

READ: Matthew 1:1-6

REFLECT: Matthew's genealogy shows how God's grace is enough for both the broken and the faithful. His grace overcame the brokenness of Ruth's ancestors and led to Jesus the Messiah. Likewise, you're part of a timeline that existed before you and will outlast you. Isn't it amazing how God's purposes are fulfilled through faithful and broken people?

RESPOND: How have those before you shaped your life? What can you offer to future generations? Seek God's wisdom to live in a way that points people to him.

Friday

READ: Hebrews 6:10

REFLECT: God's justice refers to punishing evil and also to rewarding good. God does not forget what you have done for others. He is fully aware of what you do for the good of others and his glory. Ultimately, it is his grace that enables us to do this good for others.

RESPOND: Spend time thanking God for his grace that enables you to be faithful to him. Praise him for the specific ways he has demonstrated his faithfulness to you.

Tuesdays, January 20 - February 24 | 6-7:30pm


