Monday

READ: Matthew 5:13-16

REFLECT: Jesus uses two images to help illustrate the impact we can make on the world, especially those in our circles of influence. To fulfill this call, we must be intentional in sharing our faith and doing good works. God doesn't want us to be an invisible church; He wants us to be visible for the good of others and for His glory!

RESPOND: What are some ways you can make a difference in your circle of influence? Seek out other believers you admire who are making a difference.

Tuesday

READ: Ephesians 5:7-16

REFLECT: If we want to be light, we must be different from those we are trying to reach. When we live as children of the light, it's not by trying in our own strength. Rather, it will be a result of walking in the light of Jesus. When we spend time with Him, we will naturally reflect His light in a dark world.

RESPOND: Do you notice a change in your heart and perspective the more time you spend with Jesus? How can you prioritize this time so that you can truly be a light to others?

Wednesday

READ: Colossians 4:5-6

REFLECT: The command to be wise and gracious in our interactions with unbelievers is something we don't often think about. Walking in wisdom means that we need to be thoughtful and discerning when we engage with unbelievers. We want to make sure that our words and actions are consistent with our faith and reflect the gospel.

RESPOND: How have your interactions with unbelievers this week reflected the gospel? How have they not? Spend time asking God to help you be more intentional in this area.

Thursday

READ: John 8:12

REFLECT: Jesus declared Himself to be the Light of the world, implying that He alone is our guide into full life and truth. Following Him means that we will not live in spiritual darkness. However, when we don't walk with Him, we cannot reflect His light to others.

RESPOND: What are some ways you can walk closely with Jesus? Think of others who do this well. Ask them what they do to cultivate their relationship with Jesus.

Friday

READ: 2 Timothy 4:1-5

REFLECT: The unfortunate reality of living in a fallen world is that people will still reject the gospel even when we are wise and gracious in our interactions with them. We must focus on what God has called us to do and pray for the Holy Spirit to move in the hearts of those who reject the gospel. Ultimately, it is the Spirit who works in their hearts.

RESPOND: Pray for an individual or two who has rejected the gospel. Ask the Holy Spirit to work in their lives and do whatever it takes to make them aware of their need for Jesus.
