You Asked For It: What should I do with my doubts?

John 20:1-18

What should I do with my doubts?

1. EXPOSE your doubt

Mary in vs. 2 - *They have taken the Lord out of the tomb, and we don't know where they have put him!*

John in vs. 8 - *He saw and believed.*

Behind your doubt you will typically find some other belief you take on faith.

2. EXAMINE that faith

Mary responding to the angels in vs. 13 - *They asked her, "Woman, why are you crying?" They have taken my Lord away," she said, "and I don't know where they have put them.*

"Everyone has a LORD - someone or something you're putting your faith and trust in. Who/What is that for you?

3. EMPOWER your hope by...

- ...Doubting your doubt

The Disciples didn't understand... vs 9 - *They [the disciples] still did not understand from Scripture that Jesus had to rise from the dead.*

- ...Gazing at the empty tomb

When you do so, hopefully you hear what Mary heard in vs. 16: Jesus calling your name.
