A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR ANDY

SPIRITUAL LEADERSHIP GENERATOR An Opportunity for YOU!

You're invited to learn what it means to be a spiritual leader and live into your calling! Over the last three years, 40 Troy Methodist Church members have completed the **Spiritual Leadership Generator**, a process for developing everyday followers of Jesus into spiritual leaders. I would love for YOU to join the ranks!

I participated in our first year of SLG, but the curriculum has been updated and streamlined, so I'm looking forward to participating again. Would you join me? We'll look at biblical leadership through the life of Christ and dive into leadership concepts that can be directly applied to your life.

Completing this course will help you:

- Integrate your learnings spiritually, relationally, emotionally, and vocationally
- Develop your spiritual leadership
- Sharpen your leadership skills
- See your call and begin to embody your call

Details:

- 4 newly designed modules over 8 months in a cohort of 4-5 people
- Weekly 90-minute meetings video and discussion + application and accountability (your group can meet at any time during the week)
- 2 one-day retreats worship, formation, relationship, vision-casting Kickoff on Saturday, January 31, 2026 (9:30 a.m. 4:00 p.m. with lunch at TMC)
- Shared learning experience that is two-fold: learning and formation content learning of some key concepts and cohort learning that's being formed spiritually
- Learning from the experts in the field integration of high-quality content by professors and practitioners
- Additional monthly coaching for each group facilitator
- **COST**: Although the actual cost of this seminary level, two-semester course is \$795, we are only asking you to invest \$350. The rest will be offered through a scholarship from our church's leadership development budget.




ANGEL TREE MINISTRY



WINTER SEASON PRAYER FOCUS FOR KIDS By Jenn Diliberto

Can you believe we're already at the end of the year?

Thank you for continuing to pray for your "bookmarked" kids - your prayers matter more than you know! As we move into the Christmas and winter season, here are five simple ways you can be praying for our kids in the weeks ahead.

1. Joy That Lasts

Scripture: "The joy of the Lord is your strength." - Nehemiah 8:10

Prayer Focus: Pray that each child finds true joy that doesn't depend on gifts, grades, or activities - but on knowing <u>Jesus. Ask God to fill their hearts with His joy</u>, even when the days grow colder and darker.

2. Peace in Every Heart

Scripture: "And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus." - Philippians 4:7

Prayer Focus: Pray for God's peace to fill kids' hearts - especially in busy homes, during exams, or when changing schedules. Ask that they know they can talk to God when they feel worried or stressed.

3. Gratitude in All Things

Scripture: "Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus." - 1 Thessalonians 5:18 **Prayer Focus:** Pray that kids will learn to be thankful - not just for presents and parties - but for God's love, family, and the little blessings each day.

4. Generous Hearts

Scripture: "It is more blessed to give than to receive." - Acts 20:35

Prayer Focus: Pray that kids will have hearts that look for ways to give - whether through kind words, helping a friend, or sharing with someone in need.

5. Growing Closer to Jesus

Scripture: "Grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ." - 2 Peter 3:18

Prayer Focus: Pray that through the Christmas story and the new year ahead, each child grows in knowing who Jesus is and how much He loves them.

STUDENT MINISTRY MEALS IN 2026


